1.3 Installation

There are two programs in the archives:

CDTVPlayer, The main controller, a commodity, which needs to be copied on the control computer.

CDPlayer, The player, needs to be copied on the boot disk of the CDTV.

1.4 Usage

The Controller:

The controller, when run, shows a small window on the Workbench screen.

Pressing the buttons numbered from 01 through 20 starts the CDTV and plays

the corresponding track. You can press several tracks one after the other in

order to play several tracks.

Pressing 'About' brings an about requester,

'Iconify' iconifies the program. When iconified, the controller can be brought back to life by either pressing the hotkey, double-clicking the AppIcon, or by

using Exchange.

Finally, 'Quit' quits the program.

The program can also be iconified via Exchange.

The Player:

The Player on the CDTV is not meant to be used manually.

It is important to have the program 'ProNer-run' on the control machine, and to have made the CDTV on the NetWork machine '0'.
