DAY 1 o COLUMBUS/EN ROUTE

DAY 2 o ROME/NAIROBI

Arrive in Rome this morning and connect with your flight to Nairobi. DAY 3 o NAIROBI/TREE HOTEL

DAYS 4/5 o MT. KENYA SAFARI CLUB/SAMBURU GAME RESERVE

Today you'll lunch at the Mt. Kenya Safari Club, a magnificent resort carved out of the wild and built on the slopes of Mt. Kenya. Continue north to the Samburu Game Reserve which is rich in wildlife not seen in other parts of Kenya. Here, you'll find the gerenuk, reticulated giraffe, dik-dik, and Grevy's zebra, along with colorful birds. SAMBURU SERENA LODGE.

DAY 6 o LAKE NAKURU

Your drive this morning takes you through the picturesque Rift Valley to Lake Nakuru, a shallow alkaline lake - the world-famous haunt of flamingos. Wildlife here includes hundreds of species of birds, as well as a variety of mammals, such as the Bohor reedbuck, leopard, hippo, the rare Rothschild giraffe and the very long-eared leafnosed bad. DAYS 7/8 o MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE

Continue to the Masai Mara Game Reserve, the northern part of the Serengeti, one of Kenya's most favored game-viewing areas. This is the Africa of your imagination: endless reaches of acacia-dotted grasslands studded with hazy hills and abundant wildlife. You will be in the Mara during the annual migration, when great herds of wildebeest (1.4 million), zebra (400,000) and other animals make their seasonal journey back to the Tanzania side of the Serengeti plains. At this time, prides of 40 or more lion may be seen. During your game runs, you will find unspoiled nature, and one of the largest varieties of animal species on earth. While in the Mara, a Park Ranger will join you and discuss animal habits and conservation (duties permitting). FIG TREE CAMP.

DAY 9 o NAIROBI/EN ROUTE

After breakfast drive back to the modern city of Nairobi. A day room will be provided at the Inter-Continental Hotel. Tonight, you will be escorted to the airport for yur flight to Europe, saying "Kwaheri" (goodbye) to Africa.
