LIBRARIES GO HIGH TECH WITH COMPTON'S NEWMEDIA CD ROM LENDING LIBRARY PROGRAM

Carlsbad, Calif. -- June 26, 1993 -- For the first time ever, public libraries will be able to lend CD ROM titles and offer and exciting, new avenue of learning and information to their communities. With the current growth of CD ROM and projections of one in nine homes having CD ROM drives by 1995, there is enough CD ROM hardware in homes and businesses to warrant a library lending program, which may attract a whole new segment of the population to libraries."

## LIBRARY PROGRAM BASED ON SUCCESSFUL RENTAL TRACK RECORD

The individual CD ROMs will be stamped "For Lending Only," similar to the CD ROMs Compton's NewMedia has provided to video rental stores in a program launched just six months ago with distributor Major Video Concepts. With video stores placing multiple re-orders, the pilot plan proved so successful that the program has now been expanded with more titles and an increased number of video stores participating.

Software rental, under current law, is illegal without approval from the software publisher. Compton's NewMedia has obtained these rights and will provide special discs and packaging earmarked for lending only. Apart from these specially marked discs, software rental is still not allowed by law.

"As with the recently announced video store rental program, Compton's continues to push the envelope in terms of distribution of its own and its affiliated CD ROM labels. This now represents our twelfth distribution channel. We intend to bring CD ROM to the public in all channels, making it as ubiquitous as video tapes are today." Bastin concluded.
