Probably the most mesmerising graphics demo you will have ever seen. See with your own eyes the results of graphic recursion! This demo requires a 386+ machine with VGA. Simply type SPIN to make it run.

Keys active are:

Entire cursor keypad interactively controls direction of spin. 0-9 sets the speed at which the image is spinning. SPACEBAR toggles recursion on/off. Notice the speedup when recursion is turned off. This is due to the fact video wait states are being avoided because the data is not being pulled directly off of screen ram.

ESC exit.

If you have a fast VGA card and a 486, this demo is pretty amazing.
