Creating a new entry in the Local Database

Working with the Custom Play List

AX-CDPlayer displays all track titles of the disc in the Available Tracks list. To create a custom play list, you must choose tracks in this list.

Click the **DISC** button, and choose the **Custom Play List** property page or Click the **MENU** button, choose **Custom Play List** and **Custom Play List** or Click the **CUSTOM** button. Removing one or more disc entries

Adding a new artist

Exporting the database

AX-CDPlayer allows you to export one or more discs from you local database into a new external file using the AX-CDPlayer format DBD. This file can be imported into another AX-CDPlayer program (a friend's program for example).

Indexing and packing the database

When you modify, suppress or move the database discs, the database inflates. To have faster access to your local database, you can launch the **Index and Pack** command. It allows reorganizing and packing the database. By default, AX-CDPlayer reindexes automatically the database when you have done 100 modifications in the Database Manager.

What is CDDB?

On the Internet, spread across the globe, are collections of servers that provide access to an extremely large database of CD titles. If you run a CDDB compatible CD player program (like AX-CDPlayer 2.1), you automatically gain access to the CD database, otherwise known as CDDB. As long as your computer is connected to the Internet, every time you play a CD your software looks up the disc you're playing and displays information such as the name of the album, song titles and miscellaneous information about the disc!

CDDB was created for the purpose of providing enjoyment to users of the Internet!

Performing a query to the CDDB server

AX-CDPlayer integrates access to the CDDB server. If the option "Automatically query CDDB each time a new disc is inserted" is checked in the dialog box "Preferences" when you insert a CD for the first time, AX-CDPlayer queries the CDDB database for information on that CD. If the disc is found by the CDDB database, Disc information (Disc's title, tracks...) is automatically downloaded in the Local Database.

If the disc is found by the CDDB database

The disc is not found by the CDDB database

Submitting a disc to the CDDB server

If you have entered information manually about a new disc, you can use AX-CDPlayer to submit it to CDDB. You are encouraged to submit all the discs are not present in the database. As the submissions are sent by e-mail, the only requirement is to have access to an SMTP server through an Internet connection. If you don't have access to a private SMTP you can use a public server.

Displaying Disc and CDDB properties

- Click the **MENU** button
- Choose the DISC button and the miscellaneous property page or directly on the DISC button and the Miscellaneous property page
- In the **General Properties** group, Total Track, Total Time and Product ID are displayed In the **CDDB properties** group, CDDB Disc ID, From Server, and Date are displayed

What is the difference between the "Product ID" and "CDDB Disc ID"

- Product ID is the disc internal reference
- CDDB Disc ID is calculated by AX-CDPlayer. This ID is based on the physical disc properties (track count, track length, and disc time...). The resulting ID is used by CDDB to retrieve disc information

Maximizing or reducing AX-CDPlayer

Customizing AX-CDPlayer

Click the MENU button then Preferences

In the General Group

- **Show Welcome/Tip of the day dialog at startup**: Displays the Welcome and Tips of AX-CDPlayer
- **Show warning messages at startup:** Displays a message if you have not enough colors or if AX-CDPlayer is not by default the Windows CD Player.
- **Stop playback when exiting from AX-CDPlayer**: Allows to stop playback when exiting from AX-CDPlayer
- Ignore discs that have only a track (usually DATA disc): AX-CDPlayer ignores the DATA discs with only one track. These DATA discs are not CD-AUDIO
- Player window always visible (on top): AX-CDPlayer will be always visible in a top window
- **Show icon tray**: Allows to have AX-CDPlayer icon in the tray. You can Show/Hide AX-CDPlayer by double clicking. When you click with the mouse right button on this icon, a menu opens. You will find then all AX-CDPlayer commands.
- **Show icon in task bar**: Allows to show the AX-CDPlayer icon in the task bar when AX-CDPlayer is launched
- **Display playback information in Windows task bar**: Displays playback information (track number and Play Elapsed time) in the Windows task bar.

- "Intro Scan" delay: Increases or Decreases the delay of Intro Scan Play
- **Display**: Allows to choose the AX-CDPlayer Display color (Orange or Green)
- Full Screen: Allows to display AX-CDPlayer Full screen with a customized background color and a shade)
- Restore CD player: Allows to restore the Windows CD Player as the default player

In the CDDB Receiving group

- Choose the fastest server
- In the area **Server**, the server name is displayed

In the Area Port, the access protocol of the CDDB server is displayed

- To update the list of valid servers (Internet download) click the **Update the list button**
- To test the access to the server (highly recommended), click **Test the server**
- Click the **Connect to CDDB servers using HTTP protocol** if you are connected to Internet via a LAN (Local Area Network)
