# The Five Reading Methods

**TIP:** Practice daily reading at speeds faster than you are comfortable with. This will increase your reading speed both with the software and in daily life.

## RSVP

Rapid Serial Visual Presentation – The RSVP reading method flashes the text onto the screen one word at a time thereby forcing you the reader to read every word. A typical reader only reads about two out of every three words in a document. Using RSVP you will read and retain more information faster than normal reading.

**TIP:** Put the reading speed to 100 to quickly and efficiently skim a document.

## South-North Scrolling

Use this method to have the text flow from the bottom to the top of the screen. The software controlled speed will allow your eyes to stay focused on one line and not drift. Increasing the speed will force you to read faster.

## Ticker Tape

Like the stock market symbols that fly across TV, ticker tape continually updates the reading area allowing for you, the reader, to read faster with less work.

## Tele-type

Using the screen as if it was a type writer, tele-type promotes focusing on single letters at high speed forming words. This will make the reader focus on the word for a longer period of time thus increasing retention and understanding.

## **Window(ed)**

The Window method of reading uses Tachistoscopic Scroll Presentation technology to move a window across the text. In essence the window is moving your eyes for you allowing you to concentrate more and to read faster.
