SCSI

This dialog box displays the SCSI card installed in your computer and displays available SCSI addresses. To get help, click on any underlined topic.

OK button Cancel button Displays the scanner you have selected as the default scanner. This scanner remains the default scanner until you select a new one from the Current Scanner list and then click on the Make Default button.

Lets you select a scanner from the ones that are connected to your computer. Click on the arrow to display the complete list of scanners.

Makes the current scanner the default scanner.

Displays information such as the product code for your HP ScanJet Scanners. You may need this information if you are troubleshooting problems with your scanner.

Closes the dialog box and saves any changes you have made.

Closes the dialog box without saving any changes you have made.

Tests for the correct installation of the current scanner. If you get an error, follow the directions in the message and then refer to the *Installation Guide* for the HP ScanJet Scanners.

Tests for the correct installation of the Automatic Document Feeder (ADF). If you get an error, follow the directions in the message and then refer to the *Automatic Document Feeder User's Guide*.

Tests for the correct installation of the optional adapter for scanning transparencies. If you get an error, follow the directions in the message and then refer to the guide that comes with the transparency adapter for HP ScanJet Scanners.

Selects the SCSI (small computer system interface) card that you want to view free addresses for. For more information, see the *Installation Guide* for the HP ScanJet Scanners.

Lists all SCSI addresses that are available for use on the selected SCSI card. Remember the number of one of these empty addresses so that you can set the SCSI address switch on your scanner to that address. For more information, see the *Installation Guide* for the HP ScanJet Scanners.
