



Convert

The Convert program enables you to convert email addresses and bookmarks from another Internet software program. Convert runs automatically when you install TotalAccess on a system when AOL, Internet Explorer or Netscape are found in the registry. Bookmark and address book files from these applications can be converted. The eligible files are listed on this screen. Highlight the items you would like to convert then click **OK**.

Once the conversion is complete you will be asked if you would like to notify addressees in the converted address book of your new email address. If you click **Yes**, the [Notify](#) program launches.

Components List

Lists the eligible components found on your system. Currently convert can import bookmark files or address book files from AOL version 3.0 and 4.0, Internet Explorer versions 3.0 and 4.0, and Netscape versions 3.0 and 4.0.

Notify - Change of Email Address

The Notify program enables you to let friends and relatives know about your new email address. Initially the notification list shows the names and email addresses of the people that were included in the address book files you converted. You can [add](#) or [remove](#) names from this list.

Enter your old email address so it can be included in the notification message. To see the text of the notification message as it will appear when sent to your friends, click the **View Email** button.

TotalAccess can send "change of address" notifications to people you wish to notify about your new email box. You can add or remove addresses from this list using the buttons on the right. Press Send to send the notifications.

Domain Name Server (DNS)

A computer that converts Internet names, such as www.earthlink.net or news.earthlink.net to their corresponding IP numbers, such as 206.250.94.20 or 206.250.94.20.

Usenet

A world-wide system of discussion groups, with comments passed among hundreds of thousands of machines. Not all Usenet machines are on the Internet, maybe half. Usenet is completely decentralized, with over 10,000 discussion areas, called newsgroups.

Email

(Electronic mail) Messages, usually text, sent from one person to another across a computer network.

Username

Your username will uniquely define your identity at EarthLink. While your username can be anything you wish, it is most common to use a combination of your first and last names. For example, if your name is Bob Smith you may want to consider the username "bsmith" or "bobs". However, another EarthLink user may have already taken a common username so you may need to be creative in your choice. Your username can be up to 12 characters long. It can consist of any combination of lowercase letters and numbers, but must begin with a letter. A username CANNOT contain any uppercase, punctuation, or special characters.

Your Internet e-mail address will be your username followed by "**@earthlink.net**". Therefore your full Internet e-mail address might be "**bsmith@earthlink.net**".

To connect to EarthLink you must add **ELN/** (in uppercase) to your username. Therefore your username might be "**ELN/bsmith**".

Password

Your password must be between 6 and 8 characters long. It can consist of any combination of letters and numbers. However, your password cannot contain any punctuation or special characters. For security reasons, avoid using your username or the word “**password**” as your password. Passwords are case sensitive, therefore if you choose to use uppercase characters, be sure to make a note.
