Corel VENTURA 8 Installation Notes

Corel does not recommend installing Corel VENTURA 8 applications over any previously released version (e.g., Corel VENTURA 5, Corel VENTURA 7). Please ensure that you install Corel VENTURA 8 applications to a new folder.

Corel VENTURA 8 may be installed into the same folder as the CorelDRAW 8.0 installation.

Users who purchased CorelDRAW 8.0 and who have installed Corel VENTURA 8.0 into the same folder should ensure that they have obtained and installed the latest CorelDRAW 8.0 service patch from the Corel Web Site (www.corel.com). A service patch should currently be available on the web site.

When installing and uninstalling this application, take note of any color profiles, scripts or sample files that you may have modified and saved to its original name. To prevent the removal or overwriting of your current color profiles, scripts or sample files that you may have modified, ensure that you first copy the modified files to another location before installing updates or uninstalling this application.

Disk space required for this installation may vary depending on drive configuration. For example, a 2Kb file on a FAT (File Allocation Table) formatted disk will occupy 16Kb on a 1Gb drive, and 32Kb on a 2Gb drive. The install bases its calculation on the actual file size and not the required disk space size. Therefore, installing to a large, partitioned drive that is FAT formatted, and is quite full, lack of space errors may be encountered towards the end of the installation.

Corel VENTURA 8.0 and CorelDRAW 8.0 share common Writing Tool registry entries. In the event that the Writing Tools portion of the installation for one of these applications is uninstalled, the Writing Tools will be disabled for the remaining application. This will occur if only the Writing Tools component is chosen to be uninstalled. To re-register the Writing Tools for the remaining application, run the file comreg.exe from the \Programs folder. This will re-register the installed Writing Tools files in the remaining application.

Corel VENTURA 8.0 and Corel WordPerfect 8.0 share common Writing Tool files, but have different registry entries. It is for this reason that Corel does not recommend installing these applications into the same path (e.g., \Corel\Graphics8). Please install these applications into separate folders to ensure full Writing Tool functionality.

Corel VENTURA 8

Adobe Acrobat

For optimal publishing results when publishing or printing to Adobe Acrobat, we recommend these settings for cleanest output.

In the Print Dialog Box - Click the Postscript Tab and enable output color bitmaps in RGB. In the Print Dialog Box - Click the Miscellaneous Tab and Scroll down the list of special settings to Bitmap Font Limit (PS) and change the setting from 8 to 0.

Hyperlinks for Chapters and Files is not supported. Publishing as URL's and Internet addresses is supported.

Artistic Text

Under the Edit Text Window | Options | Text Options and Spelling there are several items related to Artistic Text that have no effect in Corel Ventura 8.0. This is functionality inherited from CorelDRAW and is only available within that application.

AutoNumbering

When setting up AutoNumbering, Z_SEC tags will have the same properties as the paragraphs that they accompany when they are generated for the first time.

Text in tables cannot be AutoNumbered. This is because tables do not hold files, and AutoNumbering can only be performed on named files.

Bitmaps

Plug-ins cannot preview duotone images, instead the duotone images will be previewed as grayscale.

Resample and Convert to Bitmap are memory intensive. When you create or resample a bitmap that is the full size of the screen, the uncompressed file size is very large. Ensure you have enough free virtual memory to complete the operation.

Any Bitmap Color Mask applied to a bitmap will not be visible in window previews of any bitmap effects' dialog.

In order to use Adobe PhotoShop's plug-ins in DRAW and PHOTO-PAINT, a file called MSVCRT10.dll is needed, which can be found in any of Adobe's products that supports Plug-ins.

Chapter/Page Numbering

Please note that, while you can set numbering in headers and footers, the only place you can set the numbering style (i.e., 1,2,3 or a,b,c) is in the Chapter properties dialog (Counters tab).

Clipart

The clipart collection contained on CD#2 is in Corel Media Folders. To view the clipart in Windows NT 4.0, the Corel Media Folders application must be installed or Internet Explorer 4.0 (Standard Installation) is required.

Under Windows 95 the Corel Media Folders contained on CD#2 will appear as regular Windows folders. Installation of Corel Media Folders is not necessary for browsing the CD. To take advantage of full searching capabilities for keywords and notes, or thumbnail printing, install Corel Media Folders from the main setup on CD#1.

Conditions can be applied to paragraphs tagged with the $Z_CAPTION$ tag, or, other user-defined $Z_tagnames$, such as " $Z_MYOWNTAG$ ".

Cross-References

Please note that the Navigator does not automatically update in the Markers/Cross-references page. To refresh this page to display all of your markers and cross-references, simply click the Refresh button.

Edit In CorelDRAW and applying Effects to graphic objects.

Applying an interactive transparency or other similar Effect to a vector graphic image that has been placed in CorelDRAW as a result of clicking Edit in CorelDRAW option, may result in the image appearing as a grayscale image, when the graphic is returned back into Corel VENTURA 8.

CorelDRAW 6.0 is not supported for Edit in CorelDRAW

Frames

Support for file types that can contain masks has changed. In Corel VENTURA 7 we only supported masks in EPS files. In Corel VENTURA 8 we will support masks in all file types in our filter list that support these elements. For this reason, version 7 files that contain pictures that have masks will appear differently in version 8 because the mask will be active (embedded pictures from version 7 file will not be affected since their mask information will have been lost on embed.)

To make frames spread across pages in version 7 you had to enabled frame spread. In version 8 frame spread is turned on automatically when you resize/move a frame across pages.

Frames with captions that are rotated then resized or skewed then resized will cause the caption to become disassociated from the parent frame.

Spread frames that have captions will sometimes behave erratically when rotated.

Frames and/or graphic objects that are placed in the area beyond the pasteboard are unaccessible with the mouse pointer. To select and reposition these frames you can select the page the object belongs to and the use the tab key to toggle to it. You can then reposition it using the property bar or the associate dialog.

Spread frames belong to the left page always. For this reason if you are not in facing pages mode then you will not be able to edit these frames on the right page. When in facing pages mode this is not an issue.

Bitmap Plugins

The bitmap effect filters and plug-ins are the same ones that are found in PHOTO-PAINT. Some of these filters require a mask to be present. Corel VENTURA represents masks for viewing purposes but they are not active masks as they would be in bitmap-editing applications. For this reason these filters may have different results in VENTURA then they would in bitmap-editing applications.

Bitmap effects sometimes require that a certain color model (eg. CMYK) to be used. If your picture file does not use that model then certain effects may be inactive for that file. You can use the convert option in the bitmap flyout menu to convert your picture file to the correct color model. Be aware that the optimal color model for bitmap editing is RGB.

Headers/Footers

VP7 did not wrap text in headers if the text is tabbed to the end of the line. Because VP8 does do this, opening a VP7 pub with more tabs than the line will accommodate will wrap, and the header frame will therefore be bigger than it was in VP7 to accommodate the extra lines.

When using pages with different widths in the same publication, the header or footer paragraphs will indicate that the properties have been overridden from the default settings.

The default Z_HEADER and Z_FOOTER paragraph tag settings are based on the Default Page tag.

When clicking on header or footer text, a flag () will appear next to the Z_HEADER or Z_FOOTER tag in the Paragraph Tag list box.

This flag appears because, the tab settings for the Z_HEADER and Z_FOOTER paragraph tags had to be overridden for the tab settings to reflect the different page widths.

To avoid this flag, create new header and footer paragraph tags for the narrower pages.

Headers and Footers are frames (and tags in VP8) unto themselves. Although they sit physically on a page tag, they are not, strictly speaking part of the page tag. Therefore, if you want to copy or mirror them, please ensure that you have a header or footer selected and not the page tag. Conversely, copying/mirroring page tag properties will not include headers and footers.

Importing Picture Files with objects or channels

Importing images that have channel masks that are active or not will import with the channel mask enabled. Importing images that have objects contained within them and have a background behind the objects will merge the objects with the background.

Importing images that have objects contained within them and have a transparent background will merge the objects together to one layer and maintain the transparent background.

Importing Text Documents

Additional font codes are sometimes inserted at every paragraph upon import of documents originating in wordprocessors. In order to eliminate the bulk of these font codes, ensure that Create Tags from Paragraph Overrides on Import and Open is set to on. This option can be found in Tools, Options, Workspace, Save. In some cases, extra font markup may still remain in the imported file. This can be removed manually in the Copy Editor.

Netscape 4

If two images are published side by side, where both images are left aligned and the first image has a greater height value, then the first image will not draw correctly. The image appears cropped. This problem does not occur in Netscape 3.X or in an Microsoft Internet Explorer Browser.

Node Editing Frames with the Node Edit Tool

Node editing frames with the Node Edit tool will not refresh the screen until the tool is de-selected or until a manual refresh has been forced by the user via the CTRL+W.

Page Tags

The Page tag borders button in Tools | Options | View sets the color of frames which are on Page Tags. The Frame borders button sets the color of frames which are on pages in Page Layout view. The color of the Page Tag pasteboard is taken from the Frame borders color setting.

If you override any Page Tag property, including frames or other objects on a Page Tag, the General tab of the Page Properties dialog will show a list of the differences between the overridden page and its Page Tag. If Page Tag Headers or Footers has been enabled or disabled, this will display as "Page Header" or Page Footer".

If any other Header/Footer property, such as color, columns, etc., is changed then this will be displayed as "Frames/Graphic Objects".

Printing

Duotones separations do not show up in print preview if preview view settings are set to normal with low res bitmaps.

If you are experiencing kerning problems when printing to an Hewlett Packard LaserJet 4 or 5P non-postscript printer go to Print Preview | Setting | Driver Compatibility dialog and enable "All text as graphics" option.

Section Cross References

When inserting cross-references to section numbers with the Reference All occurrences option enabled. The section numbers are listed in the order in which the markers being referenced were inserted. Therefore, you must ensure that you insert your text markers in the order in which you want the section numbers to be cross-referenced. For example, in a publication with paragraphs numbered 1-10, if you want the resulting cross-reference to be 1,2,3 you must place your text marker in paragraphs 1 then 2 then 3. Inserting them in the order 2, 3 and 1 will produce the cross-reference 2, 3 and 1.

Variable Markers and Text Markers

Giving Variable Markers and Text Markers the same name will produce unpredictable results. The Navigator will only display the Variable Marker name. The Text Marker may also not exist in the Cross-Reference or the Edit Marker Name dialog boxes.

Workspaces

When a different workplace is chosen, that workplace has to be set as current, otherwise, any setting displayed in the Options dialog will not reflect the settings in the selected workplace; any settings changed will not be saved to the chosen workplace either.

When adding a new workspace for the first time, which is based on the workspace of the '_default,' the new workspace will actually be based on the setting of Corel VENTURA's initial workspace, even if the _default workspace has different settings already. Therefore, the _default workspace and the new workspace will end up with all the settings equivalent to Corel VENTURA's initial workspace settings.

Corel VENTURA and Corel PHOTO-PAINT will load the default Regional Settings (e.g., units of measure), as set in Control Panel, Regional Settings. Should Regional Settings be changed at a later date, the Coreldraw.ini and/or the photopnt.ini (located in the \Workspace\Application\workspace name folder) must be deleted in order for this change to be recognized by the applications. Please note that custom application settings will be returned to default settings after deleting these files.

Writing Tools

The following languages are supported in Corel VENTURA 8's Writing Tools:

The English language Spell Checker is installed by default during a Typical and Compact Installation. To install additional languages, run the Setup from CD#1. Choose Custom setup. Advance to the Writing Tools page within the Setup Wizard. Choose the desired language(s) to install.

Corel VENTURA 8.0 and CorelDRAW 8.0 share common Writing Tool registry entries. In the event that the Writing Tools portion of the installation for one of these applications is uninstalled, the Writing Tools will be disabled for the remaining application. This will occur if only the Writing Tools component is chosen to be uninstalled. To re-register the Writing Tools for the remaining application, run the file comreg.exe from the \text{Programs folder. This will re-register the installed Writing Tools files in the remaining application.

Miscellaneous

Opening Booklet or Book layout publications from version 5, the page may not look correct on open. Reapplying the Page tag will fix the page.

There is no MS Word 1, MS Word for Mac 1,2,3 or Multimate import filter in Corel VENTURA 8. When importing older files that have these formats, these text files will not appear.

Open your publication/chapter in VENTURA 3.x to 5.x and use File/Type Rename to change the format to a supported format in VENTURA 8, such as WordPerfect, ASCII, etc.

Flag remains beside tag name in Paragraph Tag List after Updating the Tag Update Tag button never greys out in Paragraph Properties dialog.

Overridden paragraphs displays a 'flag' beside its paragraph tag name in the Paragraph Tag List and may fail to remove this flag after 'Updating the tag'. To correct this Open the Paragraph Tag list and reselect the tag name from the list. A prompt will pop up asking you to reformat the paragraph using the selected tag and simply click OK.

This situation can also be identified by Differences from Tag section on the General Tab of the Paragraph Properties. It will be identified as Effect Font.

This does not mean that the 'Update tag' command did not work properly, but rather, it only neglected to send this specific change to the paragraph tag. If you do not re-tag this paragraph at this point, it will maintain it's entire list of paragraph properties, which may seem redundant (hence why 're-tagging' the paragraph is suggested) and as such, tag level changes to these corresponding properties will have no effect on this paragraph, all the while that it is overridden.

Retaining Word Processing Styles on Import

Save the file in your word processor as RTF (Rich Text Format) and disable the Ignore style checkbox on the import dialog.

Corel VENTURA 8 Import/Export Filters

Some Import and Export filters contain more than one filter type within them. Although limited filter files may have been chosen for installation, access to other filters may be provided. No additional files were installed for these filters. Should you not wish to have access to these additional filters, it is possible to remove them from your filter list. Filter lists can be customized using Tools, Options, Global, Filters. Edit the list of active filters to include only those you wish to have access to.

Corel VENTURA Printing & Color Management

The Corel Commercial Printing Guide contains references to 'Corel Color Manager.' The Corel Color Manager application has been renamed to the Corel Profile Wizard.

Color correction controls are now located in Tools, Options, Global, Color Management.

Pantone spot colors are displayed and printed to RGB devices using the standard sRGB values provided by Pantone Inc. When separating or otherwise outputting to CMYK devices, the CMYK values used are those provided standard from Pantone Inc.

Enable the Map Pantone Spot Colors into CMYK Gamut option in Tools, Options, Global, Color Management if you wish the Pantone spot colors to be treated the same a CMYK color model, as they were in previous versions.

Corel VENTURA 8 defaults to Postscript Level 2, the default in past versions of Corel VENTURA was Postscript Level 1. If PS errors are received when printing, ensure that Corel Ventura's Postscript language level matches your printer's PS level.

When using lenses, transparencies, or drop shadows, the crispness of the output can be altered by changing the resolution that these items will be rendered at. This control is located in the special settings on the Miscellaneous tab of the Print dialog.

sRGB vs. RGB in Corel VENTURA and PHOTO-PAINT

sRGB is a new standard that was jointly developed by Hewlett-Packard and Microsoft. It standardizes an RGB palette, removing the need for color profiles or descriptions when printing or displaying graphics.

Corel VENTURA 8 and Corel PHOTO-PAINT 8 deal with RGB colors differently then in previous versions. Corel VENTURA 8 has adopted the sRGB standard in defining RGB colors rather then using it's own RGB, as in previous versions. From a user's standpoint, there will be very little difference, visible as minor color differences when using RGB colors. Files created in previous versions of Corel VENTURA or Corel PHOTO-PAINT will maintain their numeric RGB values in version 8.

CoreISCAN and Scanning

Microsoft Windows NT4 and Scanning

Service pack 3 must be installed on WINNT4 in order for scanning to work properly.

TWAIN Compatibility

TWAIN.dll's version 1.6.0.3 and Twunk_16.exe\Twunk_32.dll version 1.6.0.1 must be used. Please note: some scanner software has been known to overwrite new versions.

Manufacturer's Scanner Drivers

Always use the latest drivers from the manufacturer. These can usually be obtained from the manufacturer's website.

Free Disk Space

To avoid application instability, ensure that you have adequate swap file space at the commencement of the scan. If application instability is still an issue, make sure that TWUNK 16.exe is not running on your system.

AGFA Fotolook 2.0.8

Version 2.0.8. and earlier is not supported. Please upgrade to version 2.0.9. or later.

Canon IX-3010

16-bit grayscale depth is not supported.

Canon ScanCraft CS

Please update your driver to 3.0.1a or later.

Casio Digital Camera 16-bit Driver

Pressing Escape when the driver is active will causes CorelPHOTO-PAINT and CorelSCAN to go into an non-responding mode. This is common with other bitmap editing applications.

Epson 2.20

The 16-bit driver is not supported. Please use the 32-bit driver.

When canceling an image, ensure that the red error light is not flashing and that the scanner is in its Ready state before continuing.

Ensure that when Testing the Scanner Driver in the Configuration Manager, that the Epson scanner is turned on.

Hewlett Packard Deskscan 2.3 and later

The Test Scanner Driver function will fail if you have an ADF attached to your scanner. Image shifts from selected area.

Hewlett Packard PrecisionScan Driver 1.0

This driver is not supported.

Microtek ScanWizard 2.30 and later

Time-out problems may be experienced when scanning at a resolution under 100 DPI. Read the Error.txt that is provided with the driver.

Kodak DC50 Digital Camera

You cannot keep the manufacturer's user interface displayed after a scan.

Other:

We are not supporting 4 bit per pixel depths in version 8.

As well, 48-bit scanning is not supported in CorelSCAN, the image will be converted to 24-bit RGB.

Thumbnail display is not available from CorelSCAN when run as a stand-alone.

Selection of memory, buffered, and file mode is no longer available in CorelPHOTO-PAINT.

CorelTWAIN Drivers

Update your Adaptec SCSI Driver to 1.3 or higher. CorelTWAIN drivers are no longer supported for this version, but can be used with the following restrictions:

Epson

You cannot use this driver with newer scanner models. It only functions on the 600C, 800C, and 1000C. It cannot read the SCSI bus properly. Therefore, you cannot scan with this driver at all.

Fujitsu ScanPartner Series

Error indicating that " A serious error occurred and to ensure that there is adequate space." You must reboot and re-installed this driver.

Hewlett-Packard 32 Bit

Cannot rotate an image 270 degrees. You will receive an error to free up some memory even though there is enough available.

Cannot cancel a scan; it will still scan the image anyway.

Cannot scan with an Automatic Document Feeder.

Microtek ScanMaker II/III

Cannot cancel a scan; it will still scan that image anyway.

Ricoh IS/ FS2/ IBM 2456

Rotation of scanned image produces very poor results. You cannot rotate an image 270 degrees. You cannot scan at less than 100 DPI. You will receive a message stating that an error occurred while trying to create scan buffers and to free some memory. This happens in Paint 7 as well.

Corel PHOTO-PAINT 8

Web Browsers and JPEG images

Please note that 32-Bit JPEG images are not currently supported in Web Browsers. If you are saving Progressive JPEG images for the Web, make sure that your Web Designer and/or Browser supports Progressive JPEG.

Watermark detection

Watermark detection will not work automatically on opening a CPT file (even when the corresponding checkbox is set). You must first load the file and set the "File">"Export">"Detect Watermark" option.

3rd Party Plugin Filters

The Squizz plugin filter will experience problems if running on Windows NT 4 with 16M of RAM or less. This seems to be a general problem with this plugin and the current work around is to increase the RAM. This problem does not occur under Windows 95.

The KPT plugin filters do not work properly with CMYK images. The plugin works best with 24-Bit images.

Some of the dialog boxes for the plugins do not support video screen display of 256 colors or less and consequently the display is very poor. The current work around is to increase the video screen display to 16-Bit [32k colors] or higher.

When using the MagicMask plugin (and it's older version - Chromatica), the mask does not apply to the final image. This is a problem with the plugin and CorelPHOTO-PAINT (7 & 8). Chromatica has acknowledged the problem and provided this work-around:

- 1. Engage MagicMask as normal.
- 2. Do all your masking in MagicMask.
- 3. When done click OK.
- 4. Before doing anything else hit "Ctrl K"
- 5. Then hit "Ctrl F"
- 6. Then hit "Ctrl K"

The Mask will now be active in CorelPHOTO-PAINT.

Blur and Sharpen Effect Brushes

The Effect Tool brushes, Blur and Sharpen, will not operate correctly on objects in 16bit Grayscale or 48bit RGB images.

Display Issues

When the tutors are loaded, docked or undocked, the tutor display may become blank and grey. Pressing the home button at the top of the tutors, will return it to the home page and restore the display.

Control Buttons

The buttons at the top of the tutors may not appear three dimensional when the mouse is moved over them. In certain cases, instead of the Back and Forward buttons being greyed out, they may not appear at all. This does not affect the functionality of the buttons.

Using Large Fonts in Windows

If large fonts are used, then the Basic Tutorials graphic on the home page may not be visible. If it is not, then clicking the blank area between Welcome and Workshops will still access the Basic Tutorials.

An Album Converter is provided in the Graphics Utilities folder for converting older Corel Mosaic 5.0 catalogs/libraries, Corel Gallery and Corel Multimedia Manager Albums to Corel Media Folders 8 format. Double-click the Album Converter to convert the files to a Corel Media Folder.

The Corel Media Folder Indexer helps you find files using the Text Search method. The Indexer stores the keywords and notes in a file that is activated when you perform a Text Search. To have control over this file you can choose a Corel Media Folder, subfolder, or file and right click to select Index, Delete. The keywords and notes created for the selected item, will be deleted from the Indexer file.

The Indexer can be set to run manually or automatically. To run the Indexer automatically, you can preset it to update its keywords and notes file periodically. To update the indexer manually, you can right click the folder or file whose indexing you want to update. Choose Index, Update to update the indexer on the newly added keywords and notes. The Text Search method can't be used until the Indexer is run on keywords and notes.

The Corel Media Folder Indexer will run during an uninstall to convert any of the Media Folders you have created to normal Windows folders.
