

AGNS - A Game Of Naval Strategy (Version 2.0) Shareware Version Readme First

System Requirements

AGNS is a MS Windows program that runs on an IBM PC or compatible. It requires approximately 1 meg of hard disk storage space including shared dll's such as VBRUN300.DLL which you may already have installed on your computer. You should have at least 640x480 VGA color. A sound card is optional

Overview

AGNS is a shareware program. You can think of shareware as try before you buy software. It is not free software or public domain software. If you like the program and use it for more than a 30 day trial period, you must register the program. AGNS is copyrighted by K.I.S. Software.

AGNS is a game of naval warfare which you play against the computer. The units represented in AGNS (including aircraft) resemble naval units which fought in World War II. Game includes 5 levels of play, 4 "view" options including hidden movement along with options for sound, random events and individual ship names.

The shareware version is fully functional except that you will not be able to play at the higher levels. Registration information is contained in file **Order.wri**.

Installation

To install the program, run ANGSETUP.EXE from the MS Windows Program Manager. After installation you should read the README.WRI file for the latest information on AGNS. Extensive program documentation is included in the on-line help. Please note that file VBRUN300.DLL is not supplied with the installation. This is the dynamic link library for Visual Basic 3.0. You probably have this file. If not it can be downloaded from any of the major on-line services as well as most BBS's.

The install program, will backup all files that are replaced and will create a log of all files installed (INSTALL.LOG).

Shared Files

The installation program installs the following files in the Windows\System directory if the current version in Windows\System is older that the version in the installation program.

- *THREED.VBX (4/28/93)
- *GRID.VBX (4/28/93)
- *PICCLIP.VBX (4/28/93)
- *CMDIALOG.VBX (4/28/93)
- *COMMDLG.DLL (3/31/94)

Uninstall

To uninstall AGNS, simply click the Uninstall icon in the AGNS Program Group. After running Uninstall, files that were replaced remain in the Backup directory (assuming you selected the backup option). These can be restored at your option.
