Overview:

Maxit is simple to learn, difficult to master. It's a challenging and addictive game where you try to beat the computer by thinking ahead. You attempt to force the computer into taking the lower numbers, while leaving the higher numbers for you. The help file fully explains the game using graphics and simple instructions. As the game progresses, a snazzy 256-color picture is revealed in the background. In addition to normal registration, there is an option for a (very) adult registered game which features the model shown in the shareware version. Please email us if you are using SWREG and you want the adult version (instructions are in the help file.) Give it a try!

Installation:

- 1.) Copy the files MAXIT.EXE and MAXIT.HLP to any directory (MAXIT is suggested as a directory name.)
- 2.) Copy the files GRID.VBX, VER.DLL, DDEML.DLL and MMSYSTEM.DLL to the WINDOWS/SYSTEM directory.
- 3.) Ensure that the file VBRUN300.DLL exists in the WINDOWS/SYSTEM directory -- it very often does exist. The program won't run without it. If you need this file and cannot acquire it from the normal sources (CompuServe, Internet, friends, work, etc.), Bethlehem Computing will supply it for free on 3.5 diskette provided you send us a \$5 processing fee. The file is always included on the registered versions.
