### Overview

The Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service provides the easiest way to see which of your friends are online and to communicate instantly with them. It enables you to find and communicate with all your friends, whether they are signed on to America Online or signed on to Netscape AOL Instant Messenger.

To start, you create a list of all your online buddies—friends, family, and coworkers who are AOL members or have registered as Netscape AOL Instant Messenger users. Whenever they sign on, you can see them in your Buddy List window and they can see you in their Buddy List windows. When you know a buddy is online, you can use the Instant Message™ feature or the Buddy Chat feature to begin exchanging messages with that person.

### **Additional Features**

- § Buddy controls allow you to determine who can communicate with you. You can allow anyone to send you messages, limit your communications to a small circle of friends, or block messages from specific people.
- § Using personal profiles, you can display information about others or share information about yourself, such as your e-mail address or a link to your web page.
- § A warning feature allows you to help regulate the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger community. If someone sends you an annoying or offensive message, you can issue a warning to that person. The warning slows the rate at which that person can send and receive messages. If enough people send warnings to someone, that person can lose the ability to send and receive messages for a while.
- § You gain quick access to AOL NetFind™, the easiest and most comprehensive way to find what you are looking for on the Internet.
- § Find a Buddy allows you to find the screen names of those friends who already belong to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service. Sign On A Friend makes it easy to invite other friends to join and share the fun of instant online communication.

# Registering

Before you can use the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service, you need to register the software and choose a screen name. Your screen name is the name by which you will be known to everyone else using the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service and America Online. You choose a password when you register so you are the only one who can use your chosen screen name. If you are already an AOL member, your screen name has been reserved for you. However, you still need to register to use the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service.

To register, go to the AOL home page and follow the links to register and download a copy of the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger client.

You can then install the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger software and sign on with your screen name and password.

## Note

Anyone who knows your password has access to your account; therefore, you should never reveal your password to anyone online. No one from AOL will ever ask you for your password while you are online.

### **Connecting Through a Modem**

If you want to connect to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service through a modem, you need to dial in to your Internet Service Provider (ISP) first. When you are connected to the Internet, you can sign on to the service.

# **Resolving Connection Problems**

If you experience problems connecting, run the automatic configuration program to find a host and port through which you can connect. You must have a live connection to the Internet to complete this procedure.

To resolve connection problems, perform the following steps:

- 1 Click Setup on the Sign On screen.
- 2 Click Auto Configure.

The Automatic Configuration program attempts to find a host and port through which you can sign on to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service.

3 Click **OK** to save the settings and close the dialog box.

#### Note

If you want to preserve your Internet connection while you are signed on to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service, select the **Keep connection alive** check box. (Some ISPs automatically disconnect you if you have been inactive for a given period.) Every five minutes the program sends a signal to keep your connection alive, even though you may be idle.

## **Automatically Connecting and Signing On**

To make your connection to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service as quick and easy as possible, you can configure the program to start when Windows starts and then automatically sign on when you connect to the Internet through your ISP.

To connect and sign on automatically, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the Sign On screen, enter your screen name and password.
- 2 Click Setup.
- 3 Click the General tab.
- 4 Select the Save password check box.
- 5 Select the Automatically sign on when Netscape AIM starts check box.
- 6 Select the Start Netscape AIM when Windows starts check box.
- 7 In the Internet Connection box, click Modem.
- 8 Click **OK** to save the settings and close the dialog box.

## **Connecting Through a Local Area Network**

If you want to connect to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service through a local area network (LAN), for example, at work or school, you need to have a live connection to the Internet before you sign on to the service.

# **Resolving Connection Problems**

If you experience problems connecting, run the automatic configuration program to find a host and port through which you can connect. You must have a live connection to the Internet to complete this procedure.

If your local area network is behind a firewall, you must use a proxy server to connect to the service. Contact your network administrator to help you determine the configuration settings to enter.

To check and set connection options, perform the following steps:

- 1 Click Setup on the Sign On screen.
- 2 Enter the settings your network administrator supplies.
- 3 Click **OK** to save the settings and close the dialog box.

#### Note

If you want to preserve your Internet connection while you are signed on to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service, select the **Keep connection alive** check box. (Some ISPs automatically disconnect you if you have been inactive for a given period.) Every five minutes the program sends a signal to keep your connection alive, even though you may be idle.

### How the Buddy List Feature Works

When you sign on to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service, your Buddy List window appears. There are two tabs in your Buddy List window: **Online** and **List Setup**. The **Online** tab lists your buddies who are online, and the **List Setup** tab allows you to create and manage your list of online buddies.

Initially, three empty groups appear on these tabs: Buddies, Family, and Co-Workers. Add your buddies to any of these groups or create additional groups. If you don't know your buddies' screen names (from either America Online or the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service), you can find a buddy <u>by e-mail address</u>, <u>by name and address</u>, or <u>by common interest</u>.

### In the List Setup tab:

- § Each group appears as a folder.
- § The buddies in each group appear as branches from the folder. You must expand the group to see buddies in that group.
- § You cannot see which of your buddies is online when you display the List Setup tab. Click the Online tab to see which buddies are online.

### In the Online tab:

- § Groups in the Buddy List window are initially shown expanded, displaying all your buddies in each group. You can toggle the display mode between expanded and collapsed by clicking the small triangle to the left of each group name.
- § Each group has a number in parentheses to the right of the group name to indicate how many people in the group are online out of the total number of buddies in the group. For example, (3/9) means that three of the nine buddies in the group are currently online.
- § Buddy names in bold indicate the buddies who signed on most recently. Buddy names in gray and italic indicate the buddies who just signed off. You can move the cursor over your buddy's screen name to display information such as the name of the online service that your buddy is using, warnings, and online time.

### Tip

§ To toggle between the Online and List Setup tabs, press CTRL+TAB.

# Finding a Buddy by E-Mail Address

To find a buddy by e-mail address, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the **People** menu, point to **Find a Buddy**, and then click **By E-mail Address**.
- 2 Type your buddy's e-mail address.
- 3 Click Next.

## Finding a Buddy by Common Interest

You can search the Internet to find buddies with common interests. For example, if you are interested in photography, you can perform a search to find others who are also interested in photography and send instant messages to them.

To find a buddy with a common interest, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the People menu, point to Find a Buddy, then select By Common Interest.
- 2 Click Choose Interest.

The service displays a list of interests from which you must select.

- 3 Select an interest.
- 4 Click **Next** to display a list of users who share your interest.
- 5 Select a user from the Lookup Reply List window.
  To display more information about the user, click More Info.
  To send an instant message, click IM.
- 6 Click Finish when you are done.

## Adding a Buddy to Your Buddy List Window

To add a buddy to your Buddy List window, perform the following steps:

- 1 In the Buddy List window, click the List Setup tab.
- 2 Click the folder to which you want to add your buddy.
- 3 Click the Add Buddy icon:



A branch appears with the default name \*New Buddy\*.

4 Type the screen name of the buddy you want to add, and press Enter.

Remember to enter just the buddy's screen name, not your buddy's full E-mail address. For example, *johndoe*, rather than *johndoe*@aol.com.

#### Notes

- § If you don't know your buddy's screen name (from either America Online or the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service), you can find a buddy by e-mail address, by name and address, or by common interest.
- § You can invite friends who have not yet signed up to join the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service. On the **People** menu, click **Sign On A Friend** and follow the instructions.

# Adding a Group to Your Buddy List Window

To add a group to your Buddy List group, perform the following steps:

- 1 In the Buddy List window, click the **List Setup** tab.
- 2 Click the **Add Group** icon:



A folder appears with the default name \*New Group\*.

3 Type a new name for the list, and press Enter.

# **Rearranging Your Buddies**

To rearrange your buddies in your Buddy List, perform the following steps:

- 1 In the Buddy List window, select the buddy or group you want to move.
- 2 Drag and drop the entry to a different location in your Buddy List window.

## Renaming a Buddy or Group

To rename a buddy or group in your Buddy List, perform the following steps:

- 1 In the Buddy List window, click the **List Setup** tab.
- 2 Select the buddy or group you want to rename.

  The name of the buddy or group appears highlighted.
- 3 Click the right mouse button and choose **Edit** from the popup menu.
- 4 Enter the new name for the buddy or group, and press Enter.

## Sending an Instant Message

To send an instant message to your buddy, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the **Online** tab of the Buddy List window, select your buddy's screen name.
- 2 Click the Instant Message icon:



The Instant Message window opens.

3 Type your message, and click **Send**.

§ You can use the toolbar to change text or background colors, change text size, or emphasize text with bold, italic, or underlining.

## Creating a Hyperlink in an Instant Message

To create a hyperlink in an instant message, perform the following steps:

- 1 In an Instant Message window, type and select the text you want to turn into a hyperlink.
- 2 Click link on the toolbar.
  - The Edit Hyperlink window opens.
- 3 Specify the URL (Internet location) of the site you want the link to point to.
  You can also specify an e-mail address as the URL. For example, mailto:johndoe@aol.com.
- 4 Click **OK** to save the setting and close the dialog box.

### Tips

- § You can also click **link** with no text selected. If you do this, you will need to enter the link text into the dialog box. The link appears at the insertion point location.
- § If you enter an URL as text (for example, http://www.aol.com or mailto:johndoe@aol.com), the text automatically converts to a hyperlink when you send the message.

## **Saving Instant Messages**

To save instant messages to a file, perform the following steps:

- 1 In an Instant Message window, choose Save from the File menu. The Save Text to File window opens.
- 2 Enter a name for the file in the File name field.
- 3 In the Save as type field, select Text Only if you want to save just the text of the messages.
  If you want to save the text and be able to follow any hyperlinks in the messages, select AOL Rich Text Format. This creates an HTML file you can view with your web browser.
- 4 Click Save to save the messages that appear in the upper pane of the Instant Message window.

## What Is Chat?

Chat lets you exchange messages with a group of people, in contrast with the Instant Message™ feature, which enables you to exchange messages with a single buddy. The Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service provides the Buddy Chat feature, which lets you exchange messages with groups of one or more buddies in private chat rooms. Only Netscape AIM users can chat in Buddy Chat rooms.

## Inviting a Buddy to Chat

To invite a buddy to chat, perform the following steps:

- 1 In the Buddy List window, click the **Online** tab.
- 2 Select the screen names of the buddies you want to invite to the chat room.

To select multiple screen names, hold down the Ctrl key as you select each name. You can also select an entire group of buddies.

3 Click the Buddy Chat icon:



The Buddy Chat Invitation window opens.

If you want to send the invitation to additional buddies, type their screen names in the Screen names to invite field.

4 Click **Send** to send the invitation.

### Tip

You can invite a buddy to join a chat in progress. In the Chat Room window, select **People** on the menu bar and click **Invite a Buddy** to send an invitation.

#### Note

§ Only Netscape AIM users can receive Buddy Chat invitations. To see what service your buddy is using, click the Online tab in the Buddy List window, and move the cursor over your buddy's screen name. A small window appears with the service type.

## Sending a Chat Message

To send a chat message, perform the following steps:

- 1 Type the message that you want to send in the text area box of the Chat Room window.
  You can send chat messages with hyperlinks and smilles or format them using different styles such as **bold**, *italic*, or <u>underlining</u>. Using color or a different font can also help emphasize messages you send.
- 2 Click Send.

When you are finished with your chat conversation, you can save it to a file.

#### Tips

- § To stop receiving messages from someone in the chat room, select the person's screen name in the field that lists everyone in the chat room and click **Ignore**. An X appears next to the selected screen name. Click **Ignore** again to toggle the ignore feature off.
- § You can use the toolbar to change text color or emphasize text with bold, italic, or underlining.

## **Saving Chat Messages**

To save chat messages to a file, perform the following steps:

- 1 In a Chat Room window, choose **Save** from the File menu. The Save Text to File window opens.
- 2 Enter a name for the file in the File name field.
- 3 In the Save as type field, select Text Only if you want to save just the text of the messages.
  If you want to save the text and be able to follow any hyperlinks in the messages, select AOL Rich Text Format. This will create an HTML file you can view with your web browser.
- 4 Click **Save** to save the messages that appear in the upper pane of the Chat Room window.

### How Away and Idle Messages Work

If you need to step away from your computer but do not want to sign off, you can instruct Netscape AOL Instant Messenger to use the <a href="mailto:away message">away message</a> and the <a href="mailto:idle message">idle message</a> to let other users know you are temporarily not available.

For planned absences, you can turn on your Away message to let others know when you will be back. Netscape AOL Instant Messenger displays this message when anyone requests information about you and can also automatically reply with your Away message to anyone who sends you a message while you are away.

For unplanned absences, Netscape AOL Instant Messenger turns on your Idle message after 10 minutes of inactivity. Netscape AOL Instant Messenger displays this message when anyone requests information about you and can also automatically reply with your Idle message to anyone who sends you a message while you are away.

# **Defining a New Away Message**

To define a new Away message, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the Away tab.
- 3 Select the Auto respond and insert in personal profile option.
  If you do not want Netscape AOL Instant Messenger to reply automatically to messages you receive when you are away, select the Insert in personal profile only option.
- 4 Type the new Away message in the text field below these options.
- 5 Click Add Message.
- 6 Click **OK** to save your change and close the dialog box.

# Turning an Away Message On and Off

To turn an Away message on or off, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the **File** menu, point to **Away Message**, and then click the Away message you want to use. The Away message appears on your screen.
- 2 To turn off your Away message, click **I'm Back**.

# **Deleting an Away Message**

To delete an Away message, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the **Away** tab.
- 3 Select the Away message you want to delete.
- 4 Click Remove.
- 5 Click  $\mathbf{OK}$  to save your change and close the dialog box.

## Defining an Idle Message

To define an Idle message, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the Away tab.
- 3 Select the Auto respond with message option.
- 3 In the text area next to this checkbox, type the message you want to send to anyone who sends you a message while your computer is idle.
- 4 Click **OK** to save your change and close the dialog box.

  If you do not use your computer for 10 minutes, Netscape AOL Instant Messenger automatically sends your Idle message to anyone who sends you a message. To resume your service, press any key, or click a mouse button.

# **How Buddy Controls Work**

You can prevent (or block) any Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service user (or all users) from sending you messages. This feature is useful if you find someone's messages offensive or if you simply don't want to receive messages for a while. You can also specify those users who you only want to send you messages.

# **Blocking a Specific Person from Sending You Messages**

To block a specific person from sending you messages, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the Controls tab.
- 3 Select Block the users below.
- 4 Click Add Name.
- 5 Type the name of the user you want to add in the Block List.
- 6 Click  $\mathbf{OK}$  to save your change and close the dialog box.

# **Blocking Everyone from Sending You Messages**

To block everyone from sending you messages, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the **Controls** tab.
- 3 Select Block all users.
- 4 Click **OK** to save the setting and close the dialog box.

# Allowing Only Specified Users to Send You Messages

To allow only specified users to send you messages, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the Controls tab.
- 3 Select Allow only the users below.
- 4 Click Add Name.
- 5 Type the name of the user you want to add in the Allow List.
- 6 Click  $\mathbf{OK}$  to save the setting and close the dialog box.

# Allowing Everyone to Send You Messages

To allow everyone to send you messages, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the **Controls** tab.
- 3 Select Allow all users to contact me.
- 4 Click **OK** to save the setting and close the dialog box.

### **How Warnings Work**

No one patrols the Internet to make sure people remain polite or decent. If someone else using the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service sends you annoying or offensive messages, you have two ways to handle the situation. You can issue a warning to the person or you can block the person.

When you issue a warning to another Netscape AOL Instant Messenger user, the recipient's warning level increases and their ability to send and receive messages decreases. With enough warnings, the user can be prevented from exchanging any messages with anyone and may even be signed off. However, warnings are not permanent; the warning level decreases over time. If you have been warned off the service, you can return after a "cooling off" period.

You can see someone's warning level if you let the cursor hover over the person's screen name in your Buddy List window. Alternatively, you can permanently block one or more people from sending you messages. See <u>Blocking a Specific Person from Sending You Messages</u> for more information.

### To Warn Someone

To warn someone who has sent you an offensive message, click **Warn** in the Instant Message window in which you received the message.

This imposes a warning on the sender, hampering that person's ability to send and receive messages. With frequent warnings, the user will not be able to exchange any messages with anyone. Only after a "cooling off" period can that person send and receive messages again.

You can choose to impose the warning anonymously. Anonymous warnings are less severe and the person you are warning may not know who issued the warning.

#### **Notes**

- § You can issue only one warning for each message someone sends you.
- § If someone warns you, consider ending the conversation. Every additional message you send enables that person to warn you again.

### **Changing Your Password**

You can change your password whenever you are signed on to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service. You can make any change you want to your password as long as your password contains between 4 and 16 characters.

To change your password, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Change Password. The Change Password window appears.
- 2 Type your current password in the appropriate field and then type and re-type a new password in the appropriate fields.
- 3 Click OK.

#### Note

Anyone who knows your password has access to your account. Therefore, you should never reveal your password to anyone online. No one from America Online will ever ask you for your password while you are online.

### Formatting Your Screen Name

If you are dissatisfied with the capitalization and spacing in your screen name, you can change (or format) it while you are signed on.

If you want to make any other changes to your screen name, you must register a new screen name at the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger web site.

To format your screen name, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Format Screen Name.
- 2 Type your new screen name in the appropriate field.
  The only changes you can make to your screen name are the addition or deletion of spaces or the capitalization of letters. For example, if your screen name is algore, you can change it to Algore or Al Gore. You cannot change it to Tipper Gore.
- 3 Click OK.

# **Updating Your E-mail Address**

One way that others can find you and add you to their Buddy List window is through your e-mail address. If your e-mail address changes (for example, if you change jobs or switch from one Internet Service Provider to another), you should update our record of your e-mail address. This will allow others to find you by your screen name.

To update your e-mail address, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Update E-mail Address.
- 2 Enter your new e-mail address in the dialog box.
- 3 Click OK.

### **Editing Your Profile**

You can change your profile whenever you are signed on to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service. Your profile can also include up to five of your favorite interests (or hobbies) by which you want others to be able to find you on the Internet.

To edit your profile, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, click My Profile.
- 2 Select Allow People to Search for Me if you want to create a profile in the searchable directory.
- 3 Type the profile information you want to make available to other users in the appropriate fields.
- 4 Click Next.
- 5 Click I am available for chat.
  - If you don't want to specify your interests so that other users can find you and send messages to you, leave this field unchecked, and go to Step 7.
- 6 Click Choose Interest to display a list of interests, and select one.
- 7 Click Next.
- 8 Type the additional free form profile information you want to make available to other users. You can use the toolbar to change text and background color or font sizes; to make text bold, italic, or underlined. You can use the link button on the toolbar to create hyperlinks to your e-mail address and web sites.
- 9 Click Finish.

#### Note

You do not need to fill out this information in order to use the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service.

## Creating a Hyperlink in Your Profile

To create a hyperlink in your profile, perform the following steps:

- 1 Type and select the text you want to turn into a hyperlink.
- 2 Click link on the toolbar.
  - The Edit Hyperlink dialog opens.
- 3 Specify the URL (Internet location) of the site you want the link to point to. You can also specify an e-mail address as the URL. For example, mailto:johndoe@aol.com.
- 4 Click  $\mathbf{OK}$  to apply your changes and close the dialog.

#### Tips

§ You can also click **link** with no text selected. If you do this, you need to enter the link text into the Edit Hyperlink dialog. The link appears at the insertion point location.

### **Displaying Information About Someone Else**

Every user of the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service can provide personal information that is available to other users. This information includes, for example, name, e-mail address, favorite quotation, or link to a web page. This information is only available when the user is logged on.

To display information about someone else, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the **Online** tab of the Buddy List window, select the buddy whose information you want to see. The name of the buddy appears highlighted.
- 2 Click the right mouse button and choose **Get Member Info** from the popup menu. The Buddy Info screen is displayed.
- 3 Click Close when you have finished reviewing the information.

### Note

§ You can view information only about other Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service users. You cannot view the profiles of AOL members.

## Changing Sounds that Play when You Send or Receive Messages

To change sounds that play when you send or receive messages, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the Sounds tab.
- 3 Select an option in the IM Sounds group.
- 4 Click **Browse** for the option you selected.
  - The Browse for Sound dialog opens.
- 5 Select the sound you want to use and click **Open**.
- 6 Click **OK** to save the setting and close the dialog box.

### Tips

- § To test a sound, click Preview.
- § To turn a sound off, deselect the check box for that sound.

# Changing Sounds that Play When Buddies Sign On or Off

To change sounds that play when your buddies sign on or off, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the **Sounds** tab.
- 3 Select an option in the Buddy Sounds group.
- 4 Click **Browse** for the option you selected.
  - The Browse for Sound dialog opens.
- 5 Click the sound you want to use and click **Open**.
- 6 Click **OK** to save the setting and close the dialog box.

## Tips

- § To test a sound, click Preview.
- § To turn a sound off, deselect the check box for that sound.

## Setting Visual Alerts in Your Buddy List Window

You can set visual alerts to let you know when your buddies sign on or off or when they become idle.

To set visual alerts, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the Buddy tab.
- 3 To make your Buddy List window blink for five seconds each time a buddy signs on or off, select the **Flash Buddy List** window when buddies sign on or off option.
- 4 To dim the display of buddies who are idle, select the **Dim buddies after they have been idle for \_\_ minutes** option and enter the number of minutes buddies must be idle. You must enter 10 minutes or greater.
- 5 Click **OK** to save the changes.

# Changing the Font in Your Buddy List Window

You can change the default font used to display groups and buddies in your Buddy List window.

To change fonts, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the **Buddy** tab.
- 3 Select the font name and font size in which you want to display your online buddies in your Buddy List window.
- 4 Click **OK** to save the setting and close the dialog box.

### **Displaying or Hiding Information About Yourself**

You can determine whether or not other users can see how long you have had a Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service account or how long you have been idle. Other users can see this information by holding their cursor over your screen name in their Buddy List windows. You can also determine whether or not other users who know your e-mail address can use the Find a Buddy feature to learn your screen name or whether you have an account.

To display or hide information about yourself, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the Controls tab.
- 3 Select the options you prefer in the Allow other users to see and the Allow users who know my e-mail address to find groups.
- 4 Click **OK** to save the settings and close the dialog box.

## **Changing Key Bindings for Messages**

You can change the behavior of the Enter and Tab keys in the Instant Message window.

To change key bindings for messages, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the General tab.
  - If you want the Enter key to insert a line break, select the **Enter key inserts Return** option. (Deselect this option if you want the Enter key to send your message.)
  - If you want the Tab key to insert a tab, select the **Tab key inserts Tab** option. (Deselect this option if you want the Tab key to toggle among fields in the Instant Message window.)
- 3 Click **OK** to save the setting and close the dialog box.

### **Turning Smilies On or Off**

You can control whether online symbols (also known as smilles) appear in your Chat and Instant Message windows. To see which smilles can appear in these windows, see <a href="Creating a Smille in a Chat Message">Creating a Smille in a Chat Message</a>.

To turn smilies on or off, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the **General** tab.
- 3 If you do not want to see the smilies in your Chat and Instant Message windows, select the **Disable graphical smilies** option. The Smilies submenu is also removed from the Insert menu (accessed by clicking the right mouse button in a message).
  If you want to see the smilie icons in your Chat and Instant Message windows, deselect the **Disable graphical smilies** option.
- 4 Click **OK** to save the setting and close the dialog box.

### **Changing the Default Appearance of Messages**

You can customize the appearance of messages you compose by changing the default font, text color, or window color.

To change the default font used for messages:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the General tab.
- 3 Click Font.
- 4 Select the font settings you want to use and click **OK**.

The Font and Size settings only affect the display of messages on your screen. They do not change the font or size of messages you send.

5 Click **OK** to save the settings and close the dialog box.

To change the default window color used for messages:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the General tab.
- 3 Click Window Color.
- 4 Select the color you want to use and click **OK**.
- 5 Click **OK** to save the settings and close the dialog box.

#### Note

§ If you want to change the size of text you send, use the toolbar to increase or decrease it.

# Viewing the Timestamp in Messages

You can have the time included on all of your messages. To view messages with timestamps, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the General tab.
- 3 Select the **Always view time stamp** option.
- 4 Click **OK** to save this setting and close the dialog box.

# Note

§ You can choose Timestamp from the View menu of any Chat or Instant Message window to toggle the timestamp on or off.

# Why Load and Save Settings?

Loading and saving your Netscape AOL Instant Messenger settings allows you to:

- § Save your settings so you can quickly set up your account and list of online buddies on another computer. For example, you can copy your settings from a desktop computer to a notebook computer.
- § Share your settings with others. For example, you can copy the settings you use to connect to the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger server through a firewall and e-mail the file to your co-workers.

### Notes

- § Not all versions of Netscape AOL Instant Messenger can load and save settings.
- § You cannot load or save settings from an America Online account.

# **Saving Settings**

To save your settings, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu click Save Buddy List.
- 2 Select the type of settings you want to save and click **Save**.

# **Loading Settings**

To load your settings, perform the following steps:

- 1 On the File menu click Load Buddy List.
- 2 Select the file containing the settings you want to import and click Open.
- 3 Select the type of settings you want to import.
  If you are importing Buddy List Preferences, you can choose whether or not to add the groups to your existing list (Merge with my existing Buddy List). If you choose not to merge the settings, your existing list of online buddies will be replaced by the ones you are importing.
- 4 Click Load.

#### Settings You Can Load and Save

There are six types of settings you can save and load to your copy of the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger software.

### **Connection Preferences**

This setting corresponds to the settings on the Connection tab of the Preferences dialog: host server, port, and proxy information. In addition, this setting stores the setting of the Auto-login checkbox on the Sign On screen.

#### Personal Profile

This setting corresponds to the information you enter on the My Info tab of the Preferences dialog.

#### **Controls Preferences**

This setting corresponds to the information on the Controls tab of the Preferences dialog: your privacy setting, your allow list, your block list, and the settings that allow others to see your idle time or how long you have been a member.

#### Sound Preferences

This setting corresponds to the settings on the Sounds tab of the Preferences dialog. The on or off value of each option on the tab is imported or exported, but neither the sound files nor the pointers to them are saved.

#### **Instant Message Preferences**

This setting corresponds to the default text properties of your Instant Message window as you defined them on the General tab of the Preferences dialog.

### **Buddy List**

This setting corresponds to the buddies and groups in your Buddy List window. You can choose to export any or all of the groups. When you import buddy list preferences, you can choose to replace your groups with the ones you are importing or merge them into your existing groups. If you merge a group that has the same name as an existing group in your Buddy List window, the imported buddies are added to the existing group.

### **Sounds Preferences**

The Sounds Preferences dialog box allows you to set which sounds, if any, play when your buddies sign on or off and when you send or receive messages.

# Play a sound when buddies sign on

Select this option to play a sound whenever one of your buddies signs on.

### Play a sound when buddies sign off

Select this option to play a sound whenever one of your buddies signs off.

# Play a sound when first message is received

Select this option to play a sound the first time you receive a message from a particular buddy, but not on subsequent messages from that buddy.

## Play a sound when receiving a message

Select this option to play a sound every time you receive a message.

# Play a sound when sending a message

Select this option to play a sound every time you send a message.

### Tip

The Netscape AOL Instant Messenger software includes a directory of default sound files. This SOUNDS directory is located in the directory in which you installed the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger software.

#### **General Preferences**

#### Save password

If you select this option, Netscape AOL Instant Messenger saves your password, so you won't have to type it for subsequent logins.

#### Automatically sign on when Netscape AIM starts

If you select this option, you are signed on automatically whenever you launch the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service. This option is active only if you select the **Save password** option on the Sign On screen.

#### Start Netscape AIM when Windows starts

If you select this option, Netscape AOL Instant Messenger starts automatically when Windows starts.

#### **Internet Connection: Modem**

If you select this option, Netscape AOL Instant Messenger uses your modem. This option is active only if you select the **Start Netscape AIM when Windows starts** option.

#### Internet Connection: Local area network

If you select this option, Netscape AOL Instant Messenger uses your local area network. This option is active only if you select the **Start Netscape AIM when Windows starts** option.

#### Enter key inserts Return

Select this option if you want the Enter key to insert a line break. Deselect this option if you want the Enter key to send your message.

#### Tab key inserts Tab

Select this option if you want the Tab key to insert a tab. Deselect this option if you want the Tab key to toggle between fields in the Instant Message window.

#### Always view timestamp

Select this option if you want the messages you send and receive to be marked with the time they are sent.

When you are finished entering and formatting your information, click OK to apply your changes and close the dialog box.

#### Disable graphical smilies

Select this option if you do not want graphical smilies to appear in your Instant Message window. The Smilies submenu is also removed from the Insert menu (accessed by clicking the right mouse button in a message).

# Show 'Accept Message' dialog for messages from users not in Buddy List

Select this option if you want to choose whether to accept a message from someone not on your Buddy List. Whenever such a person attempts to start a conversation by sending you a message, a dialog appears asking if you want to accept the message.

If you deselect this option, messages from everyone appear as soon as you receive them.

#### Font

Click this button to select a font style and size for the Instant Message window.

### **Window Color**

Click this button to select a background color for the Instant Message window.

### Text Magnification: 200%

If you select this option, Netscape AOL Instant Messenger displays the text in your Instant Message window magnified by 200 percent. Although the text is magnified in your Instant Message window, it is displayed normally, using the font selections you made, to the buddy who receives your message.

### Text Magnification: 133%

If you select this option, Netscape AOL Instant Messenger displays the text in your Instant Message window magnified by 133 percent. Although the text is magnified in your Instant Message window, it is displayed normally, using the font selections you made, to the buddy who receives your message.

# Text Magnification: 100%

If you select this option, Netscape AOL Instant Messenger displays the text in your Instant Message window magnified by 100 percent. Although the text is magnified in your Instant Message window, it is displayed normally, using the font selections you made, to the buddy who receives your message. 100 percent is the actual size of the text.

#### Text Magnification: 75%

If you select this option, Netscape AOL Instant Messenger displays the text in your Instant Message window magnified by 75 percent. Although the text is magnified in your Instant Message window, it is displayed normally, using the font selections you made, to the buddy who receives your message.

#### **Connection Preferences**

If you access the Internet through an Internet Service Provider, you most likely will not need to make any changes to the Server or proxy sections of the Connection Preferences tab. However, if you access the Internet through a Local Area Network firewall (for example, at your workplace), then your network administrator may need to configure the proxy section of the Connection Preferences tab.

#### **Server Host**

This field contains the default Internet address of the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger server. Under normal circumstances, you do not need to change this field. If you should change it accidentally, click **Reset** to restore the default address.

#### Server Port

This field contains the default server port number to be used on the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger server. Under normal circumstances, you do not need to change this field. If you should change it accidentally, click **Reset** to restore the default port number.

#### **Auto Configure**

If you click this button, the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger software will attempt to configure itself to work in your computer's network environment. Try Auto Configure if you are having difficulty connecting with Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service.

#### Reset

If you click this button, the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger software will restore the default Server Host and Port values.

#### Connect using proxy

If you click this button, the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger software will activate the proxy server controls.

### **Proxy Server Host**

Supply the name of the proxy server.

#### **Proxy Server Port**

Supply the port number to be used on the proxy server.

#### Protoco

Specify whether your proxy server uses the SOCKS 4, SOCKS 5, or HTTPS protocol.

### **Authentication Username**

Supply the authentication username required by the proxy.

## **Authentication Password**

Supply the authentication password required by the proxy.

### Use proxy to resolve hostnames

Select this option if you want the proxy to act as a name server for hosts that are behind the firewall.

### Keep connection alive

Select this option if you want Netscape AOL Instant Messenger to preserve your Internet connection during idle periods. (Some Internet Service Providers automatically disconnect users who have been inactive for a given period.)

### **Controls Preferences**

## Allow all users to contact me

Select this option to allow all users to see you in their Buddy List windows and send you messages.

### Allow only users on my Buddy List

Select this option to allow only users on your Buddy List to see you in their Buddy List windows and send you messages.

#### Allow only the users below

Select this option to allow only users you specify to see you in their Buddy List windows and send you messages.

#### Block all users

Select this option to prevent all users from seeing you in their Buddy List windows and sending you messages.

#### Block the users below

Select this option to prevent the users you specify from seeing you in their Buddy List windows and from sending you messages.

#### **Allow List**

This list box is active when you select Allow only the users below. To add a Screen Name, click **Add Name**, type the Screen Name, and press Enter. To delete a Screen Name, select the Screen Name and click **Remove**.

#### Block List

This list box is active when you select Block the users below. To add a Screen Name, click **Add Name**, type the Screen Name, and press Enter. To delete a Screen Name, select the Screen Name and click **Remove**.

#### Allow users to see how long I've been idle

Select this option to enable other users to see whether you are idle when they hold the cursor over your screen name in their Buddy List window.

# Allow users to see how long I've had an account

Select this option to enable other users to see how long you have had a Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service account when they hold the cursor over your screen name in their Buddy List window.

# Allow users who know my e-mail address to find my screen name

Select this option to allow users who know your e-mail address to obtain your screen name through the Find a Buddy feature.

## Allow users who know my e-mail address to find only that I have an account

Select this option to allow users who know your e-mail address to learn only that you have an account (but not to learn your screen name) through the Find a Buddy feature.

# Allow users who know my e-mail address to find nothing about me

Select this option to allow users who know your e-mail address to learn nothing about you through the Find a Buddy feature.

# **Buddy Preferences**

The Buddy tab of the Preferences dialog box allows you to control the appearance of your list of online buddies.

#### Font

From the dropdown menu, select a font for the Buddy List window.

# Size

From the dropdown menu, select a size for the font in the Buddy List window.

# Dim buddies after they have been idle for \_\_ minutes

Dims your buddies' screen names after they have been idle for the specified number of minutes. You must specify at least 10 minutes. If you enter less than 10 minutes, the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service may not be able to report your buddies' idleness until after 10 minutes.

# Flash Buddy List window when buddies sign on or off

Flashes the Buddy List window for five seconds when buddies sign on or off.

# **Away Preferences**

The Away Preferences dialog box allows you to define messages that appear to others while you are away from your computer or while your computer is idle.

# Auto respond with message (when idle)

If you select this option and enter a message, this message is automatically sent to those who send you a message when your computer is idle for more than ten minutes.

### Auto respond and insert in personal profile (when away)

If you select this option and activate your Away message, this message is automatically sent to those who send you a message. Your Away message also appears in the Personal Profile section of the Buddy Info window when someone requests information about you.

# Insert in personal profile only (when away)

If you select this option and activate your Away message, the message appears only in the Personal Profile section of the Buddy Info window when someone requests information about you.

#### Away messages

Click Add Message and type a label and a new Away message in the text fields. After you have entered a new message, click Save.

## **Buddy Chat Preferences**

The **Buddy Chat** tab of the Preferences dialog allows you to set controls for your chat room and sounds. You can also control whether or not you receive chat invitations.

Set your chat preferences with these options:

### • Chat Room Window

Select the **Flash window when message is received** option if you want the chat window to flash when someone sends you a chat message while you are working in another window.

If you want the service to display an announcement when users enter and leave a chat room, select the **Show** announcements when users enter and leave room option.

#### Sounds

The Sounds Preferences dialog allows you to indicate which sound (if any) plays when your buddies receive your messages and when you send messages:

#### Play a sound when messages are received

Select this option to play a sound when chat participants receive your message.

# Play a sound when sending a message

Select this option to play a sound each time you send a chat message.

### Block all incoming chat invitations

Select this option if you don't want to receive any chat invitations.

# Tip

The Netscape AOL Instant Messenger software includes a directory of default sound files. This SOUNDS directory is located in the directory in which you installed the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger software.

# If You Can't Sign On

Check for one of the following instances:

- Is the password you entered valid? If not, check your case-sensitive password and try again.
- S Did your request to sign on get denied? If so, you have signed on too many times in a short period. Wait a few minutes and try again. Additional attempts to sign on now will extend the period you need to wait.
- § Are you currently connected to the Internet? If not, and you have been able to connect before, check the following:
- Ø Is your Internet Service Provider (ISP) connection operating properly? If not, contact the company supplying your connection and be prepared to change your connection configuration.
- Ø Is your LAN connection operating properly? If not, contact your LAN network administrator and be prepared to <a href="mailto:change\_your connection configuration">change\_your connection configuration</a>.

You might not be able to sign on if:

- § Your Internet connection is only 16-bit. The Netscape AIM service needs a 32-bit connection. Contact your ISP if you are not sure
- § There is a DNS problem with your ISP or network. Contact your ISP or system administrator, or try again later.
- § Your network is using a <u>firewall</u>. If this is the case, contact your system administrator for information about setting up a proxy server. After you obtain this information, you must enter it in your <u>Connection preferences</u>.
- § The Netscape AIM service is temporarily unavailable. Try to sign on again later.

If none of the above conditions is true, there is either a temporary problem somewhere in the network that is preventing the connection from completing or the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger server is down. In either case, you simply need to wait and try again later.

# **To Change Your Connection Configuration**

- 1 Click **Setup** on the Sign On screen.
- 2 On the Connection tab, enter the settings supplied by either the company supplying your ISP connection or your LAN network administrator.
- 3 Click **OK** to save the settings and close the dialog.

# If You Can't See Anyone in Your Buddy List Window

§ Have you added any buddies to your Buddy List? If not, click the **List Setup** tab in the Buddy List window and click the **Add Buddy** icon:



- § Are you viewing the **Online** tab in the Buddy List window? If not, click the **Online** tab in the Buddy List window to display your online buddies.
- Are any of your buddies signed on? If not, they won't appear in your Buddy List. On the **People** menu, click **Sign On A**Friend to invite a friend to register with the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service.
- Is the **Block all users** option selected? If so, this prevents anyone from seeing you and also prevents you from seeing anyone in your Buddy List window. To deselect the **Block all users** option, on the **File** menu, point to **My Options**, and then click **Edit Preferences**. Click the **Controls** tab where you can deselect the option.
- § Are all of your buddies blocking you? If so, on the **People** menu, click **Sign On A Friend** to invite another friend to register with the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service.

# If You Can't Send Instant Messages

- Is your buddy blocking your instant message? If so, on the **People** menu, click **Sign On A Friend** to invite another friend to register with the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service.
- § Is your buddy signed on? If not, you need to wait and try again later when your buddy is signed on.
- § Did you exceed the <u>rate limit</u> for sending instant messages? If so, wait until the power bar under **Send** turns yellow or green.

### **Rate Limit Definition**

The rate limit is a technical constraint the Netscape AOL Instant Messenger service uses to encourage users to use the service in a reasonable manner. As your rate limit decreases, the rate at which you can send messages decreases. If the rate is low enough, you are unable to send any instant messages. Your current rate limit is displayed in the power bar under **Send**.

Two factors determine your rate limit:

- § The rate at which you send instant messages
- § Your warning level

If you try to send a lot of messages quickly, you decrease your rate limit. Each time you receive a warning, your warning level increases and your rate limit decreases.

You cannot reset your warning level or your rate limit. Gradually your warning level will be reduced and your rate limit will increase, but you must be patient and behave to return to a normal state.

# If Your Web Browser Doesn't Open Properly

If your web browser doesn't open, check to make sure you did not remove your default web browser accidentally? If so, you need to either register an existing browser as the default web browser with your operating system's Registry, or you need to install a new web browser.

# If Your E-Mail Program Doesn't Open Properly

If you e-mail program doesn't open, check to make sure you did not remove your default e-mail program accidentally? If so, you need to either register an existing e-mail program as the default e-mail program with your operating system's Registry or you need to install a new e-mail program.

# If You Want to Disable Automatic Launch

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the **General** tab.
- 3 Deselect the **Start Netscape AIM when Windows starts** option.
- 4 Click  $\mathbf{OK}$  to save this setting and close the dialog box.

# If You Want to Disable Automatic Sign On

- 1 On the File menu, point to My Options, and then click Edit Preferences.
- 2 Click the **General** tab.
- 3 Deselect the Automatically sign on when Netscape AIM starts option.
- 4 Click  $\mathbf{OK}$  to save this setting and close the dialog box.

# Firewall

A firewall is a computer system that is placed between networks to restrict traffic to and from an organization for security reasons.
