This is a beta release and there will be at least one update. If you wish to distribute this program, see the file "VENDINFO.DIZ". If you have any problems, please report them.

INSTALLATION:

"Discover Juggling 1 - Balls" is delivered as either the Windows self extracting file "JUGGLE1.EXE" or as the compressed file "JUGGLE1.ZIP". Both install the same files and requires about 2.4 megabytes (2,400,000 bytes) on your hard drive. Once installed, the file "JUGGBALL.EXE" is the main "Discover Juggling 1" program. Use "Run..." from the Program Manager's "File" menu or use the File Manager to run "JUGGBALL.EXE". To create Windows icons for this program, click the "Create Windows Icon" button at the bottom of the first shareware screen.

To install "JUGGLE1.EXE" from Windows, use "Run..." from the Program Manager's "File" menu or use the File Manager to run "JUGGLE1.EXE". By default, files are installed to C:\MIDIAGE and this document ("JUGGBALL.WRI") is automatically displayed.

To install "JUGGLE1.ZIP", create the directory "C:\MIDIAGE" and then use an unzip utility such as PKUNZIP or WinZip. If you need a copy of these utilities, try <http://www.winzip.com> on the Internet, or GO WINZIP on CompuServe, or ask the SYSOP of your BBS.

Other "Discover..." products from Midi Age Productions install to the same directory. Any files of the same name, such as all the ".UCD" files, can be over written. Other files that can be over written are "README.TXT", "FILE_ID.DIZ" and "VENDINFO.DIZ". These files are either used only once or are used by distributors. They can be safely deleted from your hard drive.

DDE.UCD	- Required file for JuggBall.EXE

UNINSTALLING:

To uninstall this program, delete the files listed above. By default these files are installed to C:\MidiAge, however this can be changed during installation. If you created Windows icons via the first shareware screen of "Discover Juggling 1", use the Program Manager to delete any

"Discover Juggling 1" icons in the "Midi Age Productions" group. Other programs from Midi Age Productions use this same group so you may want to keep the group name. If you have other "Discover..." products installed, do not delete any of the ".UCD" files or "APDGV.VDR"
