1.2 The Boot Tool

The Boot Tool

Don't you hate demos that have no exit, thereby forcing you to reboot after every demo viewed? Well, I can't change those demos, but I can make the rebooting as painless as possible.

If you drag the program 'BootTool' from the Tools drawer to your WBStartup drawer (OS 2.0 and up), you'll be seeing the list of no-exit demos at every startup. You can click any of those demos to run it. After the reboot, that demo and all that were above it will be removed from the list automatically.

If you want to show all demos again, click 'Show All' at the bottom of the list and reboot. If you want to stop viewing demos, click 'Uninstall' at the bottom of the list. You can, however, drag the BootTool to the WBStartup drawer again and continue from where you left off.

1.7 Huge Demos

These are two very big demos on Aminet CD 11. The first you've already seen in the list of best demos: The UnderWorld demo from The Party 95.

It needs to be started from a harddisk, where you need to have 14M of free space. To extract it to there, use the following steps:

1. Click on tp5_dld.lha
2. In the upcoming window, type a partition name or directory in the string requester and press RETURN. Decompression takes a while.
3. Check the indicated path from the Workbench, you'll see a directory called 'UnderWorld', and inside a program called UnderWorld. Start it. Enjoy. Note: This demo expects a PAL Amiga, patch your system accordingly.
4. After completion (or after reboot) you can remove the UnderWorld directory. Unless you have plenty of spare HD space.

Now if you thought that a 14M demo was big, how about a 76M one? Try this one if you have that space. I've written a small frontend for it that takes care of extracting everything to harddisk. You need AGA and at least 4M of RAM. Indicate an existing directory to extract to (for example a partition name), see the demo (it is started automatically) and delete it yourself when appropriate. Before you start unpacking, disable your screen blanker since it inteferes with the demo.
