The REBEL RIFFS Music

Mostly made these days on Fast Tracker II in XM format, although earlier tracks were released in a GUS only 'demo' type format but we switched in order for more folks to hear the Rebs in action. A full discography can be found at the end of this file. All XM's are tested on a variety of soundcards (best on a GUS or an AWE32 obviously :-)) and players including Cubic Player (the best of the best !) for DOS and Mod4Win for Windoze (the best for Windoze but where's the Windows tracker ??).

The Samples

Being the aural magpies we are, the samples we use come from everywhere (but special thanks to Sound & Vision BBS, SunSite Europe for their extensive patch libraries). Patches used in the

very latest tracks may also come from the excellent SoundWave collection from Chad Gould (cgould@gate.net) and from the ever-expanding collection of great sample CD's from Time and Space (<http://www.timespace.com>) and the utterly superb 'Cube' samples from Best Service (<http://www.bestervice.de/>). Other than that, the main vocal and fx samples come from the following Internet Newsgroups: alt.binaries.sounds.movies, alt.binaries.sounds.misc, alt.binaries.sounds.cartoons, alt.binaries.sounds.tv etc. You will also find Rebel Riffs themselves are active on most of the 'binary' and 'mod' type newsgroups (ie alt.binaries.sounds.mods etc).
