1.2 Multi Read Introduction

***What is it?***
```

This is a simple little rexx script I wrote to replace the standard RF command, which I wrote because I was tired of having to type in the complete path/filename to each file when browsing through multiple ANSI files.

The Features are:

- 1: Uses a file requestor to select files. (On local ports only.)
- 2: Allows Selection of multiple files.(On local ports only.)
- 3: Supports same usage as the original RF command.

1.3 How to use it!

Usage

When used in Local mode:

- 1: You can type "RF <filename>" and it will work exactly the same as the standard RF command.
- 2: If you only type in "RF" you will be presented with a file requestor. You can select as many files to view as you wish.

When used from a remote terminal:

- 1: It will function almost exactly the same as the standard RF command. You can enter "RF <filename>", or if you only enter "RF" you will be presented with a prompt for a file name

REQUIREMENTS

Cnet V3.x (not yet tested with 4.x)
Reqtools.library, Version 38.1436** (NOT INCLUDED)
rexxreqtools.library, Version 37.95** (NOT INCLUDED)

** May Work with earlier versions of these libs. These are the versions I am using. The Latest version of reqtools are available on aminet in util/libs/ReqToolsUsr.lha

1.6 Installation!

Installation

- 1: Move MultiRead.rexx to somewhere in your Pfiles: dir.
(i.e. pfiles:bbs/)
- 2: Load BBs menu into a text editor.
- 3: Under l; Maintenance menu, change the command "RF, Read File"
so that it reads "!!RF, Read File" (Without the quotes, of
course)
(IMPORTANT!! Must be renamed to "!!RF" for remote use!)
- 4: At the end of l; Maintenance menu add the comand

RF      |{|#0pfiles:bbs/Multiread.rexx}
        ^          ^
        ^          Be sure this is the path where you placed
        ^          the file!
CTRL Q, Of course!
```

- 5: Reload bbstext/menu & your set to go!
- 6: (OPTIONAL) Load the file MultiRead.rexx into your fav text
editor. edit the Line
path="CNet:"
to whatever default path you want the requestor to use.
**NOTE: This path must end in a ":" or a "/" !!
