DeliSid4Amiga is a DeliTracker interface for the excellent Sid4Amiga by Paul Heams.

I like Sid4Amiga a lot, but I thought that the GUI lacked a couple of important features, mainly a playlist and an Arexx interface. However DeliTracker has these features plus the ability to play any module format if a player is created for that format. So I spent a few evenings writing a player that glues Sid4Amiga and DeliTracker together.

## 1.4 requirements

DeliSid4Amiga requires:

- * An Amiga or an Amiga emulator ;)
- * Kickstart V37+ (2.04+)
- * 68020+
- * DeliTracker II V2.27 (available on Aminet)
- * Sid4Amiga V2.0b (available on Aminet)

1.5 installation

The easiest way to install DeliSid4Amiga is to use the supplied install script.

---

But if you feel an irresistible urge to install it by yourself, here's the procedure:

1. Copy DeliSid4Amiga to your DeliPlayers directory.
2. If you have DeliSID installed, you MUST move DeliSID to the PlayerStore directory as DeliSID and DeliSid4Amiga can't be used at the same time!
3. That's it!

## 1.6 configuration

### Configuration

Before being able to use DeliSid4Amiga you have to configure it.

When you have

installed
DeliSid4Amiga start DeliTracker II.

Now open the DeliTracker Players window either by clicking the notes in the main window or selecting Players... in the settings menu.

Verify that there is an entry called DeliSid4Amiga in the list on the right. Click on the DeliSid4Amiga entry.

Now click on the Config button in the lower left corner. This will bring up the DeliSid4Amiga configuration window.

The most important option is the location of the Sid4Amiga executable. So click on the button with a folder on it in the upper right corner of the configuration window. Now locate the Sid4Amiga executable and click OK.

You might want to change the frequency and AHI device before saving the preferences by pressing the Save button.

Make sure that the AHI device you select is configured for a Stereo++ mode and uses only 1 channel.

Descriptions of each option:

~~~~~

Sid4Amiga executable

This is where your Sid4Amiga executable is located. Use the button with a folder on it to bring up a file requester.

Priority

What priority Sid4Amiga should be run at.

---

**AHI Device**

What AHI device to use. The AHI device you select should be configured for a Stereo++ mode with only one channel. This option is overridden by Direct AHI.

**Frequency**

What frequency Sid4Amiga should use for playback.

**Mono/Stereo/Surround/Auto panning**

Select if you want to use mono, stereo, stereo surround or auto stereo panning for playback.

**PlaySID compatibility**

Improve PlaySID compatibility. Not recommended.

**Transparent ROM mode**

Transparent ROM memory mode. Overrides PlaySID compatibility.

**NTSC Timing**

Use NTSC-clock speed for tunes based on a vertical blanking interrupt. Not recommended.

**Emulate filter**

Enables SID filter emulation. Highly recommended if you have a fast CPU.

**MOS 8580 Waveforms**

Use MOS 8580(r5) waveforms.

**Direct AHI**

Use AHI Direct for playback. Overrides AHI Device.

**Mute 1-4**

Mute voices.

**Save**

Save and use current options.

**Use**

Only use current options.

**Cancel**

Discard any changes made.

Note that any changes you make will not take effect until you either loads a new SID tune or restarts the one playing.

to start listening to SID tunes! Just load them into DeliTracker and
they shall be played!

To show some more information about the SID tune currently being
played open the DeliTracker Players window. Select DeliSid4Amiga and
press the Show button.
