1. INTRODUCTION

This program generates MIDI Note Numbers. It can be used as a MIDI Keyboard to control any MIDI device (a synthesizer, a sound module...)

It works on Workbench v3.0 or higher, and hasn't been tested on earlier versions.

You must have MUI installed... and have a Midi Interface.

This program uses the midi.library (see
Installation
)

I put the source in it because you may not have a "azerty" or "qwerty" keyboard, so you could change it.

2. INSTALLATION

The only thing you have to do is to copy the file "libs/midi.library" in you LIBS: directory.

3. BUTTONS

What are all those buttons for ?

The 4 first lines are the keyboard itself.
As you push the button (or its shortcut) the program generates a Midi Note On signal on the specified MidiChannel, at the specified Velocity for the right Note Number.

The MidiChannel slider changes the basic Midi Channel.

The Velocity slider changes the default velocity, which will be used for every note sent. (ah, if a computer keyboard had velocity control !...)

To quit, just close the window...
