1.2 Introduction

Once Upon A Time..

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I am a member of a National Lottery Syndicate (who have won very little! - so far;)). I was fed up of checking the numbers of 8 people every week as the novelty wore off. So I decided to knock up a simple little program to tell me if the numbers my syndicate had chosen were the <winning ones>.

I then suddenly realised that this program saves a lot of time to syndicate members who have to trudge through their friends/colleagues numbers (Often who never check themselves!). So I started to expand the program by giving it a GUI via gadtools. After this I started adding a few features here there and everywhere until I had a reasonable looking package. The result of which you can roughly see in this demo version I have distributed.

Demo Version Restrictions..

- 1. The bottom window in the shareware version has a number of novel ideas such as syndicate forecasts, history analysis, member analysis etc etc. But in this CRIPPLED PD DEMO RELEASE you will just see a blatant advert!.
- 2. You will also notice that in the first window the buttons 'EDIT' & 'DELETE' are on their own!. This is because this CRIPPLED version does not allow you to see the other buttons such as :> 'INSERT' Inserts a new member at chosen location.
 'NEW' Brings up a requester to clear database and set number of members (Up To Maximimum of 300)
- 3. Menus aswell as HOTKEYS on the demo version are also few and far between
- 4. There are also many little features missing from this version such as:>
 - a) When the user updates the chart they can specify whether another small window pops up and tells you any winning entries.
 - b) Estimates prize money of 4 or more winning lottery balls.
 - c) More sensible tabs when editing gadgets (i.e not user number 6 backwards to user number 1!.
 - d) Saving of program config for attributes like (a), default syndicate prefs etc etc etc.
- 5. etc etc

ABOUT THE PROGRAMMER

I am 20 years old and first started programming on the BBC Computer when I was about 10. The first game I wrote was a PACMAN clone and then I did a sports game like the summer games compilations. The first computer i ever owned myself though was the C64 which admitley was just a games machine and i never tried art or assembly programming, although i did do quite a bit of music on it. I bought my first Amiga 500 in 1988/1989 because my friend had one and it blew away my C64! (He kept showing me Shadow Of the Beast and the Batmobile Part in Batman). After getting the A500 I did the odd bit of

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programming here and there such as for my A Level computer studies which took a long time! — the program ended up 5000 lines long — although it was a paint program with image effects etc!. I may even release it for A500 users if they wish so as Public Domain or as a bonus for buying 'Syndicate Pro_v1.00'.

After my 'A' levels I was put off programming and did not really do many projects and concentrated on making music via Music X and protracker. After finding that my music talent was about 43%! one of my friends got me interested in raytracing via Real3d v1.4 which was by now at rock bottom price. After a time I have never looked back and am mainly interested in creating 3D graphics for video/home (bigger productions perhaps in the future?). So you could call this my 'first' program release. Anyway time to render I suppose! see ya all later!

Finally

I hope you enjoy this program and find it useful as I do. Just would like to say that the AMIGA is the best home computer around and even beats the PC at most video applications.

1.5 How To Use Syndicate Professional (CRIPPLED PD DEMO VERSION)

How to use:

Easy GUI makes it quite logical to use!. But below are the main listed features and how to use them.

THE PD CRIPPLED DEMO VERSION has 4 Windows

The Following points explain what each of the windows do/contain:>

SYNDICATE MEMBERS (window)

- a) People's names in the syndicate can be customised by clicking on 'edit' after selecting an entry in the gadgetlist.
- b) The 'delete' gadget will delete the current selected entry.
- c) The scroll gadget shows you the syndicate members
- d) The 6 six gadgets at the bottom of the window let you enter your own lottery numbers. Please note that the numbers are only saved if you press tab or return.

WINNING LOTTERY NUMBERS

- a) There are 6 gadgets at the top of the window which is where the ${\tt JACKPOT}$ lottery numbers are updated while watching the LIVE ${\tt JACKPOT}$ DRAW on television.
- b) The other bonus cycle gadget is for the last bonus number and after updating this the 6 JACKPOT numbers will be sorted numerically.
- c) The last gadget in this window is the 'Check Numbers' which will go and look at the syndicate members numbers and tell you what you have achieved!

NATIONAL LOTTERY RESULTS

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a) The list gadget on the left is updated when the 'Check Numbers' button is pressed. It tells you who won what, i.e if they lost or won a prize etc. It is more useful with small syndicates.

b) The bar graph is a visual way of telling you if you have won anything worthwhile. This is ideal in the shareware version if you have a syndicate of 100 people or so because you can quite clearly see the number of winning entries.

WHY SHOULD YOU REGISTER

Wellermm...ermm.. is this a blatant reminder/advert/self-indulgence or what!. If you like the program and want me to continue producing software for the AMIGA then I would like some feedback. If you have any ideas for programs then do not hesitate to contact me at my friends email address. Registering also tells me that people like my program and that I should continue releasing AMIGA shareware programs, otherwise new software dissappears......
