About the Corel Wallpaper Flipper

The Corel Wallpaper Flipper utility automatically changes the wallpaper displayed on your screen each time you start Windows. You can

- use any bitmap image located in your Windows directory, including wallpaper you create using the Corel PhotoCD Lab tool
- preview an image before including it in the list of images used by the Wallpaper Flipper. The previewed image is displayed as your current wallpaper.
- To select the bitmap files you want used as wallpaper
 - 1. Double-click the Corel Wallpaper Flipper icon.
 - 2. Select the files you want to use as wallpaper images from the Wallpaper Available list box and then select **[Add]**.

-- or --

Select [Add All] to add all the images listed in the Wallpaper Available list box.

- 3. Mark the Random Order checkbox if you want the images displayed in a different sequence than the order you selected them.
- 4. Mark the Tile Wallpaper checkbox if you want multiple images of the current bitmap file displayed.
- 5. Select **[OK]**.
- To remove an image from the list of files
 - 1. Select the file name.
 - 2. Select [Remove].
- To preview an image before adding it to the list of wallpaper images
 - 1. Select the file name.
 - 2. Select [Preview].
- To turn off the wallpaper flipper, select **[Disable]** from the Wallpaper Flipper window.
