What Pegasus Mail? v1.0

We wanted a Windows 95 Utility that would notify users when they logged in whether they had any New Mail and a list of Noticeboards, each preceded by the number of Notices not yet read.

This was designed for Windows 95, Pegasus Mail and Netware Client32 for Windows 95.

Installation

WhatMail.EXE and WhatMail.HLP should be placed in a PUBLIC Area on your FileServer, with the attributes set to ReadOnly, Shareable.

The WhatMail.EXE should be placed in your Windows 95 Startup Group

Command Line Options

/AutoExit - causes the program to Automatically terminate if there are no messages.

Known Limitations

- Does not support NoticeBoards within NoticeBoards (only does top Level)
- Limited Error Checking
