

To do this **you must install Adobe Acrobat Search and ensure that the proper indexes are selected**. If you installed Acrobat Reader 3.0 from this or the accompanying CD-ROM disks, the Acrobat Search was installed automatically.


There are two (2) electronic indexes that must be loaded (if they aren't already) in order to use the Acrobat search capabilities with this CD. These need to be accessed/selected from within the Adobe Acrobat Reader 3.0 application. The index files are located on the Learning CD in the directories (folders) called FAQ\_PDFS and UFAQPDFS, respectively.
