

NEWCOLOR

The file, "NEWCOLOR.IN", is used as a redirected input file for the DEBUG program. It causes the creation of two new LOTUS 123 text driver files that feature more imaginative use of color in 123 for those using 123 with a color monitor.

To create these drivers, type: DEBUG <NEWCOLOR.IN. This assumes that that you are using DOS 2.0 or higher and that the files, DEBUG.COM, NEWCOLOR.IN, and IBM0COLO.DRV reside on the default drive and default directory. It creates two files, TDCOLOR1.DRV and TDCOLOR2.DRV, on the same drive and directory.

When you get your new files, you can try each out by copying it into TD.DRV on your 123 program directory. I have only tested this with version 1a of 123. I don't know the results when trying this with the earlier version. As a word of caution I suggest that whenever you do any kind of program patching like that being done here, always have your files backed up!
