1.2 description

DESCRIPTION:

This is just Windoze95 like system shut down. At first I think of putting it in game/gag directory but now it is quite working program. I have SVGA monitor (without 15kHz life on Amiga is very hard!) and I wanted a program for easy booting in pure AmigaShell but in 31kHz mode. It works for me for some weeks.

1.3 requirements

REQUIREMENTS:

- Amiga :)
- Workbench with MagicWB palette
- OS3.0+ and datatypes
- AGA chips aren't necessarily required but then you have to convert LOGOW.SYS and LOGOS.SYS to less colors

ShutDown should work on graphics cards under CyberGraphX but I didn't test it.

1.4 installation

INSTALLATION:

Just copy S/LOGOW.SYS and S/LOGOS.SYS to S: directory. Then edit S/Shell-Sequence (this file is required for booting in AmigaDOS mode) and put it in S:. Copy ShutDown and ShutBreak to C: and add following line to your Startup-Sequence just after SetPatch:

C:ShutBreak >NIL:

If you don't like Win95 screens (I know you hate them :) paint your own and save them in any format supported by datatypes (IFF, GIF, BMP, PCX, etc). Remember about renaming files! Only LOGOW.SYS and LOGOS.SYS names are valid. Files included in archive are in GIF format. With fast zgif.datatype loading GIFs is near as fast as IFFs. Screen mode is taken from picture.datatype so if you need to change it use screen promotor (screen titles: LOGOW and LOGOS).

For better impression install ShutDown as a launcher entry in Tiny Meter.
