1.2 What's is SimplePlayer ?

SimplePlayer is a GUI for Play16. Play16 is a sound utility that lets you play samples of any size off your Hard Drive.

Play16 version 1.6 is included in this archive by permission of it's

Author: Thomas Wenzel. (Thanks Tom!)

SimplePlayer controls most of Play16's **functions**

* SimplePlayer does not use MUI.

So if you don't have MUI, You don't need it.

1.3 How to install SimplePlayer

Just click on the install Icon..that's it.

You can put Simple Player and Play16 wherever you want.

<<<< YOU MUST RUN THE INSTALLER >>>>

Failure to do this will cause certain doom....

ie: The program will not run as intended.

1.4 Requirements to run SimplePlayer.

SimplePlayer will run on any Amiga with 2.0+

An '020 or higher is recommended for playing 16-Bit samples at 14-Bit resolution.

Read Play16's docs for more info.

1.5 How to use SimplePlayer

SimplePlayer is pretty easy to figure out.

I'm not going to go into long detail of the what's and why's of these buttons. Read the Play16 docs if you are interested in more info. I'm trying to keep this simple....

(1) Sample Number: (6) 8-bit - Output

(2) Total Samples:

(7) NTSC - Screen

(3) Current Sample:

(8) ON - Loop

(4) Test

(9) ON - Raw

(5) Status: Ready

(15) [] - Repeat

(16) [] - Filter

(10) (11) (12) (13) (14)

1) The Number of the selected sample that will be played.

2) The Total Number of samples that were selected.

3) Need I say more ?

4) The name of the current selected sample that will be played.

5) Tells you what SimplePlayer is doing with Play16 and itself

6) Current Sound Output. 8-Bit : Standard Amiga Audio

14-Bit : If you have any 16-Bit samples

Turn this on. (68000 users beware!)

14c-Bit : Sames as 14-Bit but use calibration

See Play16 archive and docs.

- 7) Screen Mode. NTSC: Select it if run your system in NTSC/PAL
VGA : Select this if you run you system in
Multiscan, DoubleNTSC, DoublePAL, etc.
- 8) Loop mode. OFF: Play the Sample once
ON : Repeat Sample forever! (or you can press stop)
- 9) Raw Mode. ON : Will play Raw Samples and anything else
OFF: Will not play Raw Samples.
- 10) Skip back one Sample
- 11) Play the Sample.
- 12) Skip forward one Sample.
- 13) Stop Stops playing The sample. If you click on it twice,
the Sample List will be reset to the beginning. This is handy
for long Sample lists.
- 14) Loads/Ejects the file list of samples. Brings up a file
requester. Supports Multi-Select
- 15) Repeat. Loops a single file or the entire Sample list.
- 16) Filter. Turns the Amiga's Low-Pass Filter (reduces the trebble) on
or off. Normally you'll want the filter off (that is the default).
But some samples might sound Dirty, or have a lot of noise, turning
the filter on might help.

1.6 Lots of neat stuff to add

- Elapsed Timer
- File Requester will "remember" last directory you were in.

1.10 SimplePlayer's humble beginings

v1.1 - Repeat option added. Will loop lists of samples.

- Filter option added. Turns the Amiga's Low-Pass filter on and off. Useful for "Dirty" sounding samples.

- Slight GUI change to make room for the above mentioned options.

- Included RequestFile 34.7 by Simon Dick. Now SimplePlayer will run on 2.x machines.

v1.0 - First Public Release of SimplePlayer.

v.9 - Fixed bug #2008. Raid finally did the trick..Got ya !

v.8 - Stop actually works now...

v.5 - Too strange to mention. Fixed it though.

v.1 - First Semi-Useable version of SimplePlayer.

V.0 - Didn't exist yet.
