Using SearchGuide

SearchGuide is NOT supposed to be used from the Shell, but from inside an AmigaGuide document.

The template is as follow:

SearchGuide VIEWER/K, PUBSCREEN/K, GUIDE/A

VIEWER is optional and is the viewer to be used to display the guide resulting from the search. If not present SearchGuide will try "SYS:Utilities/Multiview", if that fails it'll then try "Multiview".

PUBSCREEN is also optional and is used for the feedback window and as argument to the viewer for the resulting found guide, otherwise it defaults to the default public screen (at least for the feedback window;-)

The GUIDE argument is mandatory and must be the name of the Amigaguide document that is calling SearchGuide.
