1.3 Introduction to EBP

EBP is a bible viewer utility designed for Workbench 2.0 and up.

Features include:

- Single and multiple word searching.
- Phrase searching.
- Up to 11 different books can be opened at the same time.
- GUI Interface
- Uses either the Workbench screen or a custom screen

1.4 Bugs

There are no bugs that I know of yet.

1.5 Bugs

So far, I know of no bugs in the program, If you find any please let me know so I can fix them in the next release.

1.6 Installation

- 1. Extract the archive in the directory you wish the new ebp directory to be created in.
- 2. Add the following assign in your user-startup file: Assign >NIL: ebp: mydir where mydir is the full path to the directory ebp is in. Example Assign >NIL: ebp: sys:main/ebp
- 3. Reboot so the assign will take affect. Or enter the assign at the CLI.

1.7 Usage

You can start the program by clicking on the icon, or from the CLI.

Main Gadgets:

Open a Book

When you click on this gadget you will be prompted for a book to open. The book will then be displayed in it's own scrollable resizeable window. Up to ten of these windows can be opened at a time.

About

Opens the normal about requester.

Search

Opens the search requester where you define the search parameters, preforms the search, and displays the first result.

Display Matches

Displays a scrollable window of all the matches for the last search. You can then select one to be displayed.

Next Match

Moves to the next match.

Prev. Match

Moves to the last match.
