A macro to place centered text within a group of columns so the text will be automatically centered even when column widths are changed. Place the cursor in the left cell of the group of cells you want the title to span. The formula will prompt for the number of columns in the range, the text of the title, and the row to use as a reference (this avoids a circular reference error).
