Purpose

This macro prompts you for a name, then searches through your Person Category in Current, presents you with a listbox if there were more than one hit, then presents a dialog box of the results.

You can then insert the address into the current document.

Optionally, if you have changed any of the fields, you can send the new information back to Current.

If you change the name field and then Update Current, the macro will add a new item to the address book.

Current Address book format

In order for this macro to work as is, your Current address book must have the following format:

If Current is not loaded when the macro is invoked, it will load Current. This assumes that CURRENT.EXE is on the path.

Fixed a couple of bugs. Thanks to Brian Stine for finding them.
