PrintEnvelope

This macro prints an envelope, using a hard-coded Return Address and either 1) a bookmark named NameAddress, 2) the current selection, or 3) an InputBox supplied address.

Installation:

You install the macro by clicking on Install above.

You must also edit the macro and insert *your* Return Address. Search for the line that begins "MYAddress\$".

Note: This version of PrintEnvelope was written specifically for the HP Laserjet III. It relies on the internal fonts. It could, however, be adapted to work with other printers -- for example, if you have landscape soft fonts loaded permanently into the LJ's memory before loading Windows, you could install the appropriate escape sequences and add them to the font list array.

Further note: this macro directly addresses the HP Laserjet, by passing the Windows HPPCL driver. As a consequence, you cannot run this macro while other print jobs are in progress.
