screen fonts tha	The program will create a FontBook Group and Font Book icon. Click on the FontBook Icon to start the program. The program may take some time to start as it will be comparing your fonts to your printer fonts to make sure there is a one to one corespondence. The more you have the more time it will take to start.	
wish to	To display sample fonts, just click on a font in the FONTS LIST. If you have moved the focus to either the Font List or Selected Font Box simply type the first letter of the font that you access. This is a quick way of jumping down the list.	
	To change point size, click ont the desired point size in the POINTS LIST.	
	To select fonts for printing, double click on the fonts in the FONTS LIST.	
	To unselect the font just double click on the font in either the FONTS or SELECTED FONTS LIST.	
	To select the default font for all the headings on the top or margins on the side please use the pull down menu called "Output Heading Font".	
window	You can resize the window by clicking and dragging on the outside borders. Most people will find this useful by clicking and dragging on the bottom border and moving up until the is half the length. This will leave the full ansi character set and the fonts visible.	
useful	If you open the FILE MENU and click "Stay on Top" the Font Book application will float on top of any of your current applications. Click again to turn this off. This is particularly if you reduce the window size as mentioned above or have a very large video monitor.	

The FILE MENU contains the options that allow you to print the fonts in your system in either
book format or as examples of the Ansi Character Set in a fixed point size. Warning: printing
too many fonts may cause you to run out of disk space or other resources .

of 30 seconds. This means that when Font Book prints a page in book format, it will

Clicking the BOLD/ITALIC/UNDERLINE check boxes will change the Ansi Character Display to the appropriate attributes. You can also type in the sample boxes to the right and see how a sample of text will look. Double click on the sample boxes and hit delete to clear them out. You can type in the bottom input box and see your text in the BOLD/ITALIC/UNDERLINE text samples.
