- 1. There is not much in the read me yet, but to get it started I will put this additional information together.
- 2. FONTBANK should be installed in it's own directory, because there will be a fair bit of font data stored wherever the fontbank.exe file exists.
- 3. Copy the *.VBX file to your Windows System directory. They don't have to be, but it is usually better to keep your system clean and logical.
- 4. Copy the FONTBANK.INI file to your winows directory.

Version 1.02 Fixed problems of not knowing where the FONTBANK.EXE file was located.

- Version 2.0 Add capability to store fonts in user definable accounts
