1. There is not much in the read me yet, but to get it started I will put this additional information together.
2. FONTBANK should be installed in it's own directory, because there will be a fair bit of font data stored wherever the fontbank.exe file exists.
3. Copy the *.VBX file to your Windows System directory. They don't have to be, but it is usually better to keep your system clean and logical.
4. Copy the FONTBANK.INI file to your winows directory.
