- Listen carefully so you'll know what to do next.
- Stay with the Ranch Crew; we need your help in this activity!
- That's a unique way of doing things! How did you think of that? Let's try it this way.
- It's important that we all follow the instructions and work together as a team.
- Please move over here so you can see better.
- Let's all sit in a circle so we can see and hear one another better.
- Those crafts and Buddies sure are cool! Let's keep them put away so we can hear about this next activity.

DON'T SAY,

- Stop talking and get back to work.
- Be quiet and listen!
- Don't run around the room.
- You're doing it wrong!
- Don't do that!
- Stay out of that area!



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
