

Tips for Using KSE Backgammon

2002 Edition

This document contains information that will help you get the most out of KSE Backgammon.

To read this document on your screen, use the PAGE DOWN and PAGE UP keys on your keyboard. You can print the file by choosing the Print command from the File menu.

Installing KSE Backgammon

The Software Microsoft ActiveSync must be installed on your desktop computer before you can run the KSE Backgammon Setup. KSE Backgammon will be installed to your desktop computer first. Please start setup.exe to start the installation program. If you have a multi-language version you will be asked during the desktop installation which language version of KSE Backgammon you want to install. You can also choose the directory where KSE Backgammon will be installed on your desktop PC.

After the desktop installation the Microsoft ActiveSync Application Manager will try to install KSE Backgammon on your Windows CE device. If the device is not connected the download will start at the next connection. The Microsoft ActiveSync Application Manager will automatically choose the right version for your Windows CE Version and processor type.

Note: KSE Backgammon is not working with Windows CE 1.0 devices.

Changing installed language

After installing KSE Backgammon on the Desktop PC it is not possible to change the installed language. If you want to change the language please remove KSE Backgammon from your desktop PC with pressing the Remove Button in the Application Manager and reinstall KSE Backgammon with starting the setup.exe. Choose the desired language in the desktop installation.

Reinstalling KSE Backgammon

If you need to reinstall KSE Backgammon for some reason, be sure to uninstall the current version first, and then use Setup to reinstall the product. If you remove the KSE Backgammon from your mobile device you can reinstall it with the Microsoft ActiveSync. If you choose the Remove button in the Application Manager you have to reinstall KSE Backgammon from your desktop computer.

Using PCMCIA Memory Cards

Running KSE Backgammon on your Windows Ce device with files stored on a PCMCIA memory card will noticeably slow down how long it takes to play the game. To optimize performance, move the executable file from the PCMCIA memory card to a folder on your H/PC or P/PC, and then run KSE Backgammon.
