- View the various .bmp files. Keep in mind, they'll look elongated due to Microsoft's externely odd way of handling Startup/Shutdown screens.
- Move the opening.bmp -- using the DOS prompt; it's easier -- it to the C:\ home directory and rename it to: LOGO.SYS
- Then, type ATTRIB +S +H +R LOGO.SYS
- StartUp is now done.
- When you're ready, move closing.bmp and closed.bmp to the main Windows folder.

• Go to the prompt, in your main Windows directory, type:

ATTRIB -S -H -R LOGO*.SYS DEL LOGO*.SYS REN CLOSING.BMP LOGOW.SYS REN CLOSED.BMP LOGOS.SYS ATTRIB +S +H +R LOGO*.SYS

exactly as you see above, answering Yes to any silly questions or confirmations.

• Shut Down Windows all the way, then restart your computer. Enjoy!
