One final note. The program tracks the condition of your comics and approximates its current value based on its Condition and its Near Mint value. I used Near Mint as the basis of the calculation because most guide books only print Near Mint which leaves you guessing as to what all the other conditions of the comic are worth. I came up with my own formula on the values based on comic condition because I have yet to find a source that can tell me what the formula is. If anyone knows what the formula is, please e-mail it to me.
