After installation, to put the ClickDown icon on your Desktop:

1. From within Windows 95, right-click on the Start button.
2. Choose 'Open'.
3. Double-click on 'Programs'.
4. Drag the ClickDown icon from the Programs window to your Desktop.
5. Close all windows.

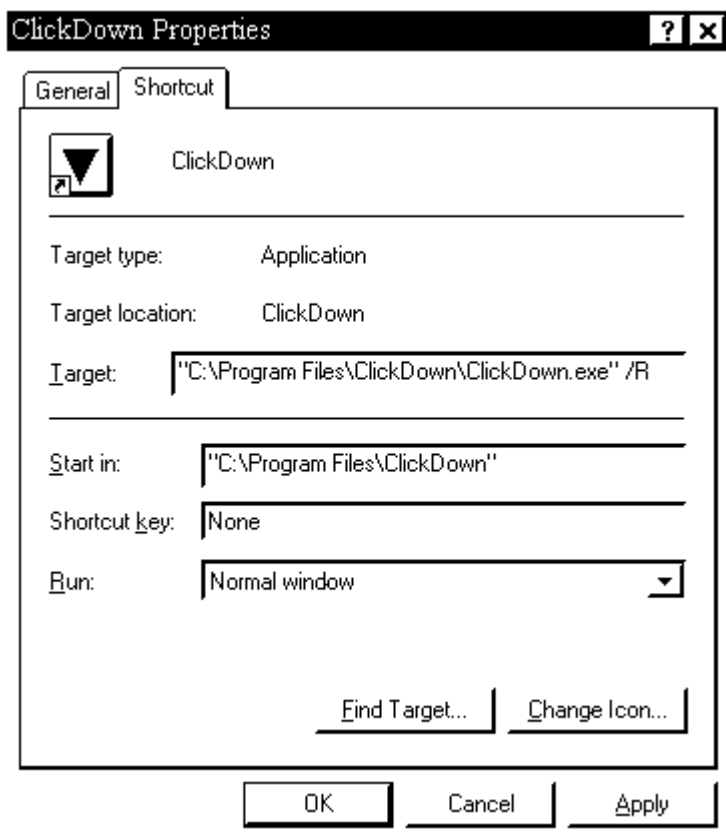
After installation, to have the ClickDown icon always appear on the TaskBar:

1. Right-click on the Start button
2. Choose 'Open'.
3. Double-click on 'Programs'.
4. Right-drag the ClickDown icon to the 'Startup' folder and choose 'Copy Here'.

To uninstall ClickDown:

1. If it is running, close ClickDown.
2. Click on the Start button and choose 'Control Panel' from the 'Settings' menu.
3. Double-click on 'Add/Remove Programs'.
4. Highlight ClickDown and click Remove.

NOTE: If you move the icon to the Desktop, it will not automatically be removed and an error message may appear.



Command Line Arguments:

These are used if you want to create an icon on the desktop to Shutdown the computer.

/? Displays about screen with program version

/R Restarts the computer

/D Restarts the computer in MS-DOS Mode.

/L Logs off (for use with networks)
/S Shuts down the computer
/T Places the ClickDown icon on the TaskBar.

The /T argument is assumed if no command line argument is assigned, or if an argument cannot be interpreted. Remember: command line arguments are case sensitive.
