Overview

FontShow for Windows 95/NT is a small program useful for viewing the TrueType fonts installed on your system. Options are included to display user-specified sample text in place of the normal font name and alphanumeric character set. The size and face of the currently selected font can be quickly changed and the results displayed automatically.

The selected font's metrics can be viewed in a small font properties window by simply double-clicking on the font name in the pick list. MS Windows stock font objects can also be displayed with this utility, making it handy for programmers and developers.

Character Set Chart

FontShow also provides a small window that displays the entire character set for the currently selected font. ASCII codes can be viewed and special characters can be copied to the MS Windows Clipboard.

Purchasing FontShow

FontShow for Windows 95/NT is a fully functioning program. It is **not** crippled in any way.

FontShow for Windows 95/NT is distributed as <u>shareware</u>. You may evaluate it free of charge for 30 days. After 30 days you are required to <u>register</u> it. If after evaluating FontShow for 30 days you decide not to register it you are required to <u>remove</u> it from your computer.

Registration entitles you to unlimited free updates and support via E-Mail or telephone.

You may also purchase FontShow for Windows 95/NT using your credit card via the Internet or by telephone.

Desktop Locations

FontShow's location on the desktop is saved when the program is exited. Whenever you start FontShow it will reappear on the desktop where you last placed it. FontShow property sheet locations are also stored and reused the next time they are opened.

Taskbar Tray

FontShow for Windows 95/NT can be optionally configured to place its program icon in the Taskbar Icon Notification Tray. This option provides a simple means of keeping the taskbar button region clear for other running programs.

Installing FontShow

Installation

To install FontShow for Windows 95/NT on your computer simply create a new, empty folder and place the files; FONTSHOW.EXE, FONTSHOW.HLP and FONTSHOW.CNT there.

FONTSHOW.EXE - The FontShow Application
FONTSHOW.HLP - The Windows 95/NT Help File
FONTSHOW.CNT - The Help Contents File

To integrate FontShow for Windows 95/NT with the MS Windows Explorer select the FontShow Explorer Setup property sheet while FontShow is running.

If you installed FontShow for Windows 95/NT using the SETUP.EXE program and selected the default installation setting FontShow for Windows 95/NT will be installed in the **C:\Program Files\Software by Design** folder.

Note If you have an earlier version of FontShow for Windows 95/NT installed on your computer, simply replace the FONTSHOW.EXE, FONTSHOW.HLP and FONTSHOW.CNT files with the newer versions.

Note The FONTSHOW.INI file is no longer used and can be deleted. The various application settings specified in the <u>FontShow Options</u> property sheet as well as the main window's size and location on the desktop are now stored in the MS Windows 95/NT System Registry.

Note Some earlier versions of FontShow for Windows 95/NT included a FONTSHOW.WRI documentation file. This file has been replaced by the FONTSHOW.HLP file and can now be deleted.

Warning If you rename the FONTSHOW.EXE file you must also rename the HLP file using the same basename. For example if you change the FontShow application file name to NewName.exe, rename the help file to NewName.hlp. Do not rename the FONTSHOW.CNT file however. The HLP and CNT files *must* reside in the same folder as the FontShow application file itself.

Configuring FontShow

FontShow Options

Select the **File | Options** menu item to display the FontShow Options property sheet. This window will allow you to change the various FontShow program settings listed below.

Show Toolbar Tips

Check this item to display small popup tip windows when the mouse pointer is placed over <u>toolbar ribbon</u> pushbuttons. A short description of the button currently beneath the mouse will be shown when this item is checked.

Dark Window Backgrounds

Check this item to display the text in list windows with a dark background instead of the paper white background MS Windows normally uses when displaying text.

Launch Multiple Instances

Check this item to allow more than one instance of FontShow to be run on the desktop. This option is useful if you would like to compare font selections.

Place Icon in Taskbar Tray

Check this item to display a small FontShow program icon in the Taskbar Icon Notification Tray. If this item is selected and the FontShow window is minimized a button will not be added to the Taskbar, to restore the FontShow window on the desktop press the small icon in the taskbar tray instead. This option is available to keep the taskbar free for other running programs.

Note When this option is selected, clicking on the Close box in the upper right-hand corner of the window title bar will minimize FontShow instead of closing the application. To quit FontShow right-click with your mouse on the FontShow icon in the Taskbar tray. You may also use the **File** | **Exit** menu command or the **Ctrl+Q** keyboard shortcut.

Confirm Program Exit

Check this item to confirm quitting FontShow for Windows 95/NT. When this option is selected you will be prompted to confirm your intention to exit FontShow and return to the MS Explorer desktop. This item is useful if you run FontShow from the tray and wish to avoid accidental exits when you right-click on the FontShow tray icon.

Sample Text for Testing Fonts

Use this entry field to define the text to be displayed when a font has been selected. The text you enter here will be displayed at the bottom of the FontShow window in the currently selected font face, style and size.

Sounds with Warning Dialog Boxes

Check this box to play a short beep sound when FontShow displays a warning dialog box or an error occurs.

OK

Press this button when you have completed your selection of FontShow program options. When you press this button the FontShow Options property sheet will be closed and your settings will be saved.

Cance

Press this button to close the FontShow Options property sheet without making any changes. If you have made any changes to the option settings, and then press this button your changes will not be used, and your previous settings will remain in use.

Help

Press this button to open the FontShow Help window and go directly to the Configuring FontShow topic.

Note The options you have selected will be saved when you press the **OK** button. The desktop location of the FontShow Options window itself will also be stored. Your settings will be saved in the MS Windows 95/NT <u>System Registry</u>.

FontShow Explorer Setup

FontShow Explorer Setup

Select the **Help | Setup** menu item to display the FontShow Setup property sheet. This window will allow you to integrate FontShow for Windows 95/NT with the Microsoft Windows 95/NT Explorer. Use this command to create and remove MS Explorer shortcuts.

Create a Start Menu Item

Check this item to create a FontShow Start Menu entry. The FontShow for Windows 95/NT program will be located in the Software by Design folder on the Programs menu. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a FontShow item already exists in the Software by Design folder.

Remove this Start Menu Item

Check this item to remove the FontShow entry located in the Software by Design folder on the Programs menu. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a FontShow item does not already exist in the Software by Design folder.

Create a Desktop Icon

Check this item to create a FontShow for Windows 95/NT program icon on the Explorer desktop. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a FontShow desktop icon already exists.

Remove Icon from the Desktop

Check this item to remove the FontShow for Windows 95/NT program icon from the Explorer desktop. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a FontShow desktop icon does not already exist.

Create a Startup Folder Item

Check this item to automatically run FontShow for Windows 95/NT whenever Microsoft Windows is started. This option creates a FontShow program icon in the MS Windows Explorer Startup folder. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a FontShow startup item already exists in the Startup folder.

Remove the Startup Folder Item

Check this item to remove FontShow from the MS Windows Explorer Startup folder. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a FontShow startup item does not already exist in the Startup folder.

OK

Press this button when you have completed your selection of MS Explorer shortcuts. When you press this button the FontShow Setup property sheet will be closed and the MS Explorer shortcuts you have selected will be created or removed.

Cance

Press this button to close the FontShow Explorer Setup property sheet without creating or removing any MS Explorer shortcuts.

Help

Press this button to open the FontShow Help window and go directly to the FontShow Explorer Setup topic.

File Menu

File Menu Commands

The File menu provides commands to work with FontShow. A short description of each item follows:

Options

Opens the <u>FontShow Options</u> property sheet and allows you to change FontShow program settings. Use this command to configure the FontShow program.

Fvit

Closes the FontShow program and returns control to the Explorer desktop. The Ctrl+Q shortcut can be used for this command

Tip Commonly used File commands can be invoked using <u>shortcut keys</u> or buttons on the <u>toolbar ribbon</u>.

Edit Menu

Edit Menu Commands

The Edit menu provides commands used to edit the contents of the FontShow display window. A short description of each item follows:

Paste Paste

Pastes the contents of the Clipboard at the current selection point in the Text Sample window. The Ctrl+V shortcut can be used for this command.

Show Clipboard

Opens the Clipboard window and displays its current contents.

Tip Commonly used Edit commands can be invoked using shortcut keys or buttons on the toolbar ribbon.

View Menu

View Menu Commands

The View menu provides commands used to change FontShow display options. These items provide a means of changing the FontShow window appearance. A short description of each item follows:

Stock Fonts

Use this command to load a list of all standard MS Windows 95/NT System fonts. The **Ctrl+S** shortcut can be used for this command.

TrueType

Use this command to load a list of all standard MS Windows 95/NT TrueType fonts. The Ctrl+T shortcut can be used for this command.

Font Properties

Use this command to open a small font properties window. The properties for the currently selected font will be displayed in this window. The **Alt+Enter** shortcut can be used for this command

Refresh

Use this command to refresh the font list. This commend is useful if you have installed or deleted fonts while FontShow is active. The **F5** shortcut can be used for this command

Chart

Use this command to display a character chart window for the currently selected font.

Minimize

Minimizes the FontShow window to a button or icon on the taskbar. The Ctrl+Y shortcut can be used for this command.

Always on Top

Use this command to keep the FontShow window top most on the desktop. When this item is checked the FontShow window will float above all other non-topmost windows on the desktop. This item is useful if you normally run FontShow with a small window that would be easily obscured by other applications. The **Ctrl+T** shortcut can be used for this command.

Tip Commonly used View commands can be invoked using shortcut keys or buttons on the toolbar ribbon.

Tools Menu

Tools Menu Commands

The Tools menu provides commands used to open MS Windows Font Utilities and Folders. A short description of each item follows:

Control Panel

Opens the Microsoft Windows 95/NT Control Panel window. The **Ctrl+P** shortcut can be used for this command.

Explore Fonts

Opens the Microsoft Windows 95/NT Explorer and displays the Fonts folder. The **Ctrl+F** shortcut can be used for this command.

Tip Commonly used Tool commands can be invoked using shortcut keys or buttons on the toolbar ribbon.

Help Menu

Help Menu Commands

The Help menu provides commands used to get help with FontShow operations. A short description of each item follows:

Contents

Opens the FontShow Help window and displays the Table of Contents. The F1 shortcut can be used for this command.

Search

Opens FontShow Help and displays the Search window. You can use this window to search for specific FontShow help topics.

How to Use Help

Opens a Help window that explains how to use the MS Windows 95/NT Help program.

Register

Displays the FontShow Shareware Registration Wizard. This wizard allows you to register FontShow for Windows 95/NT for authorized use.

Setup

Displays the FontShow <u>Explorer Setup</u> property sheet. This window provides options to integrate FontShow with the MS Windows Explorer. Use this window to create MS Explorer Start Menu items and desktop icons.

Web Site

Opens your web browser application and goes directly to the Software Design web site on the Internet.

About FontShow

Displays the FontShow splash box. This window contains program information, the current version of FontShow you are running and a program copyright notice. Click the mouse anywhere in this window to close it

Tip Commonly used Help commands can be invoked using shortcut keys or buttons on the toolbar ribbon.

Toolbar Buttons

Tool Ribbon Buttons

Most commonly used FontShow menu commands can also be quickly invoked by pressing a button on the toolbar ribbon displayed at the top of the main window. These buttons work exactly the same way as the corresponding menu items that they duplicate. The Toolbar selection on the View menu must be selected to display the toolbar ribbon.

Tip If the Show ToolBar Tips option is selected a small popup tip window will appear when the mouse pointer is placed over a button. A short description of what each button does can be viewed using this method.

Shortcut Keys

Shortcut keys allow you to quickly invoke FontShow menu commands without first displaying the menu and then selecting an item from it. The most commonly used FontShow commands can be invoked using the following shortcut keys.

File Menu

Ctrl+Q Exit FontShow, and return to the desktop

Edit Menu

Ctrl+V Paste to the current position

View Menu

Ctrl+S Load Stock fonts Ctrl+T Load TrueType fonts

Alt+Enter Show properties for current font

F5 Refresh the Font list

Minimize FontShow to a button or icon Ctrl+Y

<u>T</u>ools Menu Ctrl+P Open the MS Windows Control Panel Ctrl+F Open the MS Explorer Font Folder

<u>H</u>elp Menu

System Registry

FontShow for Windows 95/NT System Registry Key

FontShow for Windows 95/NT stores configuration settings in the MS Windows 95/NT System Registry. These settings are updated automatically while FontShow is running. There is no need to edit these settings manually.

If you insist upon editing these settings, you do so at your own risk. FontShow automatically updates registry entries when it exits. If you edit these settings make sure FontShow is not running while you edit them. If FontShow is currently running your changes will be overwritten when FontShow exits.

FontShow for Windows 95/NT stores configuration settings in the following system registry key:

If you find that FontShow for Windows 95/NT does not meet your needs you can remove it from your computer system by simply deleting the following files from your hard drive.

All of these files will be located in the folder that you originally installed FontShow in.

The default location for all FontShow for Windows 95/NT program files is the **C:\Program Files\Software by Design** folder. Unless you specified a different folder when you ran SETUP.EXE you will find the FontShow files here.

FontShow.exe FontShow for Windows 95/NT application program.

FontShow.cnt FontShow Help Topics File FontShow.hlp FontShow Help File

If you have opened and used the FontShow for Windows 95/NT Help files your system may contain the following two (2) files. These files are created by the standard MS Windows 95/NT Help program WinHlp32.exe. These files may also be safely removed.

FontShow.gid MS Windows Help settings file. This file contains the FontShow Help window size and desktop location

as well as any bookmarks you may have created.

FontShow.fts MS Windows Help word database. This file is created when you build a custom word list for FontShow

Help files. This file is used to search for words and phrases in the FontShow Help files.

FontShow for Windows 95/NT does not use any custom DLL files or system drivers. If you delete the files mentioned above from your system's hard drive you will have completely removed FontShow from your computer system.

Note If you have installed FontShow shortcuts on the MS Explorer Start Menu use the **Help | Setup** command to remove the <u>shortcuts</u> you created before you delete the FontShow files mentioned above.

What is Shareware

The concept of "Shareware"...
