BCF Help Manual Installation Instructions

If you have had any problems or errors in installing **BCF Help** using the install.exe program then **BCF Help** can be installed manually as follows:-

Copying the Required Files to Your Hard Disk

1 In File Manager create a directory on your hard disk named **BCFHELP**.

2 Copy the following files to the directory you just created

BCFHELP.HLP BCFHELP.ICO BCFHELP.WRI

3 Copy the following files to your windows\system directory FTENGINE.DLL FTUI.DLL MVAPI.DLL

Once these files are copied to your hard disk, you can then manually create a Program manager Group and Item as follows:

Creating a BCF Help Program Manager Group

1 From the File menu, choose New.

2 In the New Program Object dialog box, select the Program Group option, and then choose the OK button.

3 In the Description box in the Program Group Properties dialog box, type BCF Help.

This description will appear in the title bar of the group window and below the group icon.

4 Choose the OK button.

Program Manager creates a .GRP file for the group, so you can leave the Group File box blank.

Creating the BCF Help Program Item

1 Open the group window that you want to add an item to.

2 From the File menu, choose New.

3 In the New Program Object dialog box, select the Program Item option, and then choose the OK button.

4 Fill in the Program Item Properties dialog box as described below, and choose the OK button.

In the Description Box type BCF Help.

In the Command Line Box type WINFILE.EXEC:\BCFHELP\BCFHELP.HLP. This assumes that the drive you installed BCF Help on was your C drive, and the target directory was left as the default(BCFHELP).

In the Working Directory Box type C:\BCFHELP. Again this assumes that the target directory was left as the default(BCFHELP).

5 To display the BCF Help icon supplied, choose the Change Icon button. This will display the Change Icon dialog box.

6 In the File Name Box type C:\BCFHELP\BCFHELP.ICO in the Change Icon dialog box and then click on the OK button. This will bring you back to the Program Item Properties Box.

7 If you have completed all of the above then click the OK button and you will be returned to the Program Manager.

Changing the Winfile.exe Icon to the BCF Help Icon

1 Select the icon with the title BCFHELP that looks like a ?.

2 From the File menu, choose Properties.

3 In the Program Item Properties dialog box, choose the

Change Icon button. This will display the Change Icon dialog box.

In the File Name Box type C:\BCFHELP\BCFHELP.ICO in the Change Icon dialog box and then click on the OK button. This will bring you back to the Program Item Properties Box.

5 If you have completed all of the above then click the OK button and you will be returned to the Program Manager.

BCF Help should now be completely installed and ready to run. If for any reason you wish uninstall B then follow the procedure outlined in the **uninstal.wri** file contained on the distribution disk.
