1 John 5:11-13:







You Need to Be Baptized Join Others

You need to be baptized and join a local congregation of believers (a church) to declare your acceptance of Christ.

Acts 2:41-47:

"Then they that gladly received his word were <u>baptized</u>: and the same day there were added [unto them] about three thousand souls. And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles. And all that believed were together, and had all things common; And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all [men], as every man had need. And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the <u>church</u> daily such as should be <u>saved</u>."

<u>Baptism</u> is the first physical act you can do to show your gratefulness and obedience to God.

You should join others at church as soon as possible.

You should communicate your faith with others as much as possible.

Here's Proof of Your New Birth

You posess the Holy Spirit if God -- and it gives you evidence within yourself that you are a <u>Christian</u>.

1 John 5:1:

"Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him."

1 John 2:29:

"If ye know that he is righteous, ye know that every one that doeth righteousness is born of him."

The church is a local congregation of baptized believers who have banned together for fellowship and to propogate the Gospel.






Baptism



James 2:19:
"Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble."

The spiritual birth is more than doing good works.

Ephesians 2:8-9:

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: [it is] the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast."

Christ Died For You

The full and meaningful life is made possible by Christ's death and resurrection.

Romans 5:8:

"But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

Romans 4:25:

"(Christ) was delivered for our offenses, and was raised again for our justification."

Christ Died For You

The full and meaningful life includes forgiveness of sin.

Romans 6:23:

"For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of God [is] eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

Ephesians 1:7:

"In whom (Christ) we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;"

Christ Died For You

Christ died physically so that we would not have to die spiritually! **1 Peter 3:18:**

"For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:"

You Are Now Dead In Sin

You are dead in sin until you accept Christ as personal Savior. **Ephesians 2:1:**"And you [hath he quickened], who were dead in trespasses and sins;"

You Are Now Dead In Sin

Death is spiritual separation (your sins have separated you from God), physical separation (spirit and soul are separated from the body), and eternal separation (you are lost in your sin forever without Christ as Savior).

You Are Now Dead In Sin

One day you will have to answer to God for having not accepted Christ as Savior. **Revelation 20:11 - 15:**

"And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it....And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened...and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works....and they were judged every man according to their works....And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire."

You Are A Sinner

Failure to turn yourself over to Jesus Christ is sin.

John 3:18:

"He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."

John 10:10:



You have committed sins of commission (doing what is wrong) and sins of omission (not doing what is right) (1 John 5:17). Failure to turn yourself over to Jesus Christ is sin (John 3:18, Romans 5:12). You are a sinner (Romans 3:23).
