DJ_BothSides is a Windows 3.1 utility for Hewlett-Packard Deskjet 500 and 500C (and compatible printers) that prints ASCII text files on both sides of the paper in one or two columns or in booklet (folded) format. It's ideal for program listings, READ.ME files, on-line manuals and magazines, e-mail, wide spreadsheet output, etc.

It will save paper and help conserve your print cartridges.

Facilities

DJ_BothSides offers the following facilities:

Full multitasking (to a Centronics parallel printer port).

<u>Toolbar</u> access to frequently-used commands and options.

The names of the last four files selected or 'dragged and dropped' are remembered.

Print a file <u>dragged and dropped</u> onto its icon.

Automatic selection of an appropriately-sized typeface (Courier or Letter Gothic) and page orientation (portrait or landscape).

Support for A4, US letter and US legal paper sizes, and envelopes.

Optional double-columned and 'folded' (booklet) output.

Prints files up to $\underline{171}$ characters wide, files up to $\underline{132}$ characters in portrait orientation.

Optional <u>page footer</u> of page number, file (and/or system) date, file name and file path.

One-inch left-hand margins for easy filing, or optional page centering. Optional CG Times output and support for Hewlett-Packard's Prestige Elite and Garamond <u>font</u> cartridges.

Optional print run <u>report</u> or minimized icon during a print run.

Optional partial printing and user-specifiable tab character expansion.

Limitations

DJ_BothSides should not be used with non-ASCII, wordprocessor-specific or PostScript files, nor with files containing graphical images. (Note that many wordprocessors can export an ASCII file, that *DJ_BothSides* can print.)

It performs reasonably on files containing characters that are displayable on the screen, together with backspace, form-feed and tab. Many European accented symbols are printed also. It will not print files containing form-feeds that are more than the maximum page depth apart.

Some loss of columniation and justification may occur when a proportionallyspaced typeface is selected.



The Document menu includes commands that enable you to select a file and to print it.

For more information, select a Document menu command name:

File Select a file for printing. Print the selected file.

Print minimized Iconize main window on 'Print'.

<u>Report</u> Display the file's statistics before printing it.

<u>Options</u> Select print options.

<u>Vertical toolbar</u> Change Toolbar orientation.

<u>Autosave</u> Save options on exit.

Save options Save selected print options.

<u>Abort printing</u> Stop a print run.

<u>Exit</u> Exit *DJ_BothSides*.

The names of the last four files selected (or 'dragged and dropped') appear at the foot of the Document menu.

More frequently-used commands on the Document menu are also on the <u>Toolbar</u>.



The Port menu provides commands for identifying the printer port.

For more information, select an item:

<u>LPT</u> Parallel ports. <u>COM</u> Serial ports.

Addresses Parallel port addresses.



The Help menu provides useful information on using *DJ_BothSides*.

For more information, select an item:

<u>Index</u> Displays an index to on-line help on *DJ_BothSides*. <u>About</u>Displays information on *DJ_BothSides*.

Document File Command

Use the File command to choose the file you wish to print. Alternatively, 'drag and drop' the file onto *DJ_BothSides*' icon.

Document Print command

Use the Print command to print the chosen file using the default (or previously selected) options.

Document Print minimized command

Click on this menu item to cause *DJ_BothSides*' main window to shrink to an icon when you click on 'Print'. *BothSides* makes a beep when it's ready for paper reinsertion and when it's finished printing.



Use the Report command to obtain:

The document's file name, date and size
The number of words, lines and pages it contains
The number of blank lines and leading blank lines
Its left- and right-hand margins, and width
The average line length
The maximum page depth
Whether all lines are terminated by CR/LF
The occurrence of control and non-standard characters
A summary of the document's output format

Document Options command

Use the Options command to bring up the Print options dialogue form.

Document Vertical toolbar and Horizontal toolbar commands

Use these commands to change the orientation of the $\underline{\text{Toolbar}}$.

Document Autosave command

Check this command to cause your selections to be saved automatically each time you exit *DJ_BothSides*.

Document Save options command

Use the Save options command to save your desktop environment and choice of print options for the next time you use *DJ_BothSides*, or when you next 'drag and drop' a file onto its icon.

Document Abort printing command

Click on this menu command to stop subsequent pages being printed (and to exit the program). An Abort button is available on the <u>Toolbar</u>.

Document Exit command

Use the Exit command to leave *DJ_BothSides*.



The more frequently-used commands on the document menu are also on the Toolbar:

File

Use this button to choose the file you wish to print.

∉ Print

Print the chosen file using the default (or previously selected)

options.



Bring up the Print options dialogue form.



Save your choice of options for the next time you use DJ BothSides.



Stop your print run (and exit the program).



Use this button to exit DJ BothSides.

In addition, the following button accesses *DJ_BothSides*' on-line help information:



Use the following buttons on the Toolbar to select single-columned, double-columned or folded output (rather than using the Print options dialogue directly):



Parallel Port commands

Use the LPT1, LPT2 or LPT3 command to identify the parallel port to which your printer is connected.

Serial Port commands

Use the COM1, COM2, COM3 or COM4 command to identify the serial port to which your printer is connected.

Port addresses command

Click on this command and select the 'Calculate' button to determine the parallel printer port address. This stops a fatal runtime error when the printer is switched off.

Help Index command

Use the Index command to access *DJ_BothSides*' on-line help information.

Help About command

Use the About command to display *DJ_BothSides*' version number , copyright notice and conditions of use, together with the licensee's name.



When the Document menu Options command is used, the Print Options dialogue form appears, which is subdivided into the following groups:

Paper size
Column format
Margin
Font
Footer
Page range and tab expansion
OK and Cancel buttons

Print quality

Draft |Letter

Radio buttons that select draft or letter-quality output. (High-grade paper is recommended with the latter.)

Paper size

A4 | US letter | US legal | Envelope

Radio buttons that select the following paper sizes:

European A4 210 x 297 mm

US letter 8.5 x 11 in

US legal 8.5 x 14 in

European DL envelope 110 x 221 mm or

US No.10 envelope 4.12 x 9.5 in




For the last two, the address will have 50 mm (2 in) left-hand and top margins (approximately) provided the envelope is loaded as indicated.

Column format

Single | Double | Folded

Radio buttons that select:

single-columned output:



booklet output (which you fold in half):



Column format may also be selected using the <u>Toolbar</u>.

N.B:

Proportionally-spaced fonts are unavailable when double-columned or folded output is requested.

Double-columned output is unavailable for files containing form-feeds.

Folded output has half-inch margins (unless the 'Centred' option is requested).

Margin

1-inch LH |Centred

Radio buttons that select a one-inch left-hand margin or centred output.

N.B: centering is unavailable when a proportionally-spaced font is selected.

Font

Monospaced | Proportional | Prestige Elite | Garamond Collection

Four radio buttons that select the font to be used. Those which come as standard with your Deskjet 500 are:

The Courier and Letter Gothic **monospaced** fonts. Which of Courier and Gothic is used depends upon the maximum line width of the document.

The CG Times **proportional** font.

Those available on cartridge from Hewlett-Packard and that are supported by *DJ BothSides* are:

The **Prestige Elite** monospaced font.

The **Garamond** proportional font collection. You are invited to choose a character size from 10-, 12- or 14-point if you select this font.

The CG Century Schoolbook, Helvetica, Times Roman and CG Triumvirate cartridge fonts are not implemented (for lack of demand).



Page number footer

Page # |Page #/# |None

Radio buttons that cause the page number to be printed at the foot of each page - or not at all with 'None'.

When 'Page #/#' is selected, the total number of pages is also printed, separated from the page number by the solidus '/'.

N.B: 'Page #/#' is unavailable when the 'Start' or 'End' entry is changed.

Date footer

File date |System date |File and system dates |None

The 'File date' radio button causes the date of creation or most recent amendment for the file being printed to appear at the foot of the page.

'System date' causes the current date, as known to your system, to be printed instead.

'File and system dates' causes both dates to be printed.

No dates are printed when you select the 'None' radio button.

File name footer

Filename footer...

Check this box to cause the name of the file being printed to appear at the foot of the page...

...with path

...and this one to print its path also.

None of the page footer options is available for files containing form-feeds.

Page range and tab expansion

'Start' and 'End'

These entries are used to print some of the pages of a document. By default, all pages are printed.

'Tabs'

This entry specifies the expansion of tab characters (default: 4).

OK and Cancel buttons

OK

The OK button confirms your options selection.

Cancel

The Cancel button throws away your options selection.

Drag and drop

Make your selections in the Print options dialogue form and save them using the 'Save options' command. To print your document, 'drag and drop' its icon (from Windows' File Manager, for example) onto DJ_BothSides'

minimized icon:



Load your Deskjet's input hopper as normal.

DJ_BothSides will send the **back** pages of your document to the printer first and then display a dialogue prompting you to reinsert the paper, but don't do this until the Deskjet's busy light **stays** off.

Remove the paper (possibly including a blank page on top) from the output hopper.

[N.B: once you are familiar with using *DJ_BothSides*, this is the time to check for unexpected, completely blank pages in case the Deskjet had fed two pages at once. Remove any before you reload the paper.]

Reinsert the sheets without changing their order all together into the input hopper (on top of any unused sheets), making sure that the printed side is on the top, and:



If *DJ_BothSides* selects <u>portrait</u> mode, make sure the top edge of the paper (nearest the first line) goes into the hopper first (**turn the paper through 180 degrees**), or



If <u>landscape</u> mode is selected, make sure the left-hand edge of the paper (nearest the first column) goes into the hopper first (**no rotation is necessary**).

Ensure that the paper is nicely stacked and then click on the [Ready] button.

The document arrives in the output hopper the right way up in the correct order.

Very occasionally, the Deskjet will feed two sheets at once, messing up the whole process. It's best to start from scratch if this occurs.



Whilst *DJ_BothSides*' operation is essentially automatic, the following text widths are recommended for single-column output and all paper sizes:

The widths for the proportional fonts are necessarily approximate.

Unless CG Times, Garamond or Prestige is selected, a smaller point-size and/or <u>landscape</u> orientation is triggered for files wider than 81 characters:

^{*} For files without form-feeds, when a footer with file date, system date and page number is requested, the system date is not printed. Similarly, there may not be room for the file's pathname.

Eighty-page documents begin to get unmanageable for folding and anything less than a heavy-duty, long-arm stapler.

Reduce the chance of double-feeding by using high-grade paper (greater than 80 gsm or 16.4 pounds).



"A line in the document is too long."

The length of at least one line in the document exceeds the maximum permitted (> 400).

Solution: reduce the tab size.

"A printed line will be too long."

The length of two adjacent lines 'across the fold' exceeds the maximum permitted (> 400). This is often due to the combination of underline and bold.

Solution: reduce the text enhancement.

"Document is too wide for folded output." or

"Document is too wide for two columns." or

"Your document is too wide for printing."

Solutions: reduce the tab size and/or select single-column output.

"Double-columning is unavailable for files containing form-feeds." **Solutions**: select single-column or folded output.

"Final page is before start page." or

"Start is after last page." or

"You can't start at page 0." or

"Invalid integer entry."

Solution: refill the 'Start' and 'End' entries.

"Form-feed position exceeds the maximum page depth."
The page depth of a pre-formatted document is too large for the paper. **Solution**: read the hints in the on-line help.

"The demo doesn't print more than 16 pages. Buy the full version." Self-explanatory.

Status line

DJ_BothSides uses the status line at the foot of its main window to indicate what you could do next and to tell you what it's doing.



The demonstration version

The demonstration version of *DJ_BothSides for Windows* will not process more than 16 pages of text. Place your order for the full, unlimited version using the accompanying form.

Freely distribute the demonstration version of *DJ_BothSides for Windows* to your friends and colleagues.

Portrait orientation

With portrait paper orientation, all lines are printed parallel to the **shortest** edge of the paper.

N.B: all the Deskjet 500's internal fonts - and most Cartridge fonts - may be used with portrait orientation.

Landscape orientation

With landscape paper orientation, all lines are printed parallel to the **longest** edge of the paper.

N.B:

Of the Deskjet 500's internal fonts, only the Courier font can be used with landscape orientation.

The Prestige Elite and Garamond Collection cartridge fonts **cannot** be used with landscape orientation.
