Should you wish to run Corel GALLERY 2 from the CD-ROM, exit this installation program and run SETUP2.exe located on the CD-ROM disc. With the CD-ROM based installation, only a minimum number of files are copied to your hard drive, conserving disk space.

**Note:** If you install using SETUP2, the CD-ROM disc must be in your CD-ROM drive to run the application(s).

# **Welcome to CD-ROM Setup**

Setup shows you how to install Corel GALLERY 2 so that all the applications run exclusively from your CD-ROM disc. Only the essential files required to run the programs will be copied to your hard drive, ensuring that the least amount of disk space is used.

## **Welcome to the Network Administrator Setup**

Setup guides you through the installation of the Corel GALLERY 2 software to a local area network (LAN). At different stages in the installation process, you will be prompted to select the applications and other options you want the workstation users to have access to. For more detailed installation instructions and troubleshooting information, refer to the Corel GALLERY 2 User Manual included with your software.

After the main network installation has been completed, each individual workstation must be set up to run the Corel GALLERY 2 applications.

**Note:** Windows 3.1 or higher must be installed and working properly on the network server before installing Corel GALLERY 2.

## **Welcome to the Network Workstation Setup**

Setup shows you how to install the Corel software from the network to your workstation. **Note:** Some options may not be available for selection, depending on the parameters set by the Network Administrator.

# **Customizing Your Corel Applications**

Type your name and the software's serial number in the provided text boxes to customize your copy of Corel GALLERY 2.

After the installation is complete, this information will appear in the About dialog box (Help menu) within Corel GALLERY 2. Then, should you have to contact Customer Support, and they ask for your software's serial number, you will be able to reference it quickly and easily from within the application.

## **Choosing Installation Options**

Corel GALLERY 2 Setup offers two installation options: Full Install and Minimum/Custom.

## **Dialog Box Options**

#### **Full Install**

Automatically installs the entire Corel GALLERY 2 program group (Corel GALLERY 2, Corel CAPTURE, Corel FONT-MASTER) sample files, filters, online help, etc., to your hard drive. Approximately 16 Mbs of free disk space is required on your computer for a full installation of the software.

## **Minimum / Custom**

Automatically installs the minimum number of files required to run Corel GALLERY 2. You can, however, select additional files (online help, samples, filters, etc..) or deselect any option. The Custom Installation method also allows you to specify the destination directories where the files and applications you choose will be installed.

**Note:** Additional files can be installed later on using this option.

# **Scanner Drivers**

Programs that enable scanners to communicate with Corel GALLERY 2. Installing a scanner driver allows you to import scanned images into Corel GALLERY 2 where you can edit them to suit your needs.

# **Choosing a Directory for the Installation**

The Directory list box displays the default directory (C:\GALLERY2) where the files will be installed on your hard drive. If you prefer to install the files to a different directory, type the full path of the alternate directory in the provided text box.

# **Choosing a Directory for the Installation**

# **Selecting Corel GALLERY 2 Options**

Choose which application files you want installed to your hard drive by checking or clearing the check boxes to the left of the file names. ## Add button

- To move a single name, click on it, then choose **Delete** to move the name to the Do Not Install list box.
- To move multiple names, click and drag the mouse across the selections until they are highlighted. Choose **Delete** to move them to the Do Not Install list box.

## **Delete All button**

Moves all names to the Do Not Install list box.

## **Customizing Applications**

Lists the applications (Corel GALLERY 2, Corel FONT-MASTER, Corel CAPTURE) and file options (Import/Export Filters, TrueType fonts) you can choose to install and the default directories where the files will be copied to on your hard drive. For each selected application and option, the amount of disk space required is listed in the right-hand column. The total amount of disk space required for all currently selected applications and options as well as the amount of space available on your hard drive is listed at the bottom left of the dialog box.

## **Application/Option Check Boxes**

Select the applications you want to install by checking or clearing the check boxes to the left of the application/option names.

#### **Customize Buttons**

## **Space Required**

The total space required value is a measure of how many kilobytes of space the selected applications and options will take up on your hard drive. Included in this calculation are extra files required to run the applications.

## **Selecting Applications and Options to Install**

Lists the applications and options you can choose to install. For each selected item, the amount of disk space required is listed in the right-hand column. The total amount of disk space required for all currently selected applications/options and the amount of space available on your hard drive are listed at the bottom left of the dialog box.

Choose which symbol libraries you want installed by adding or deleting library names to and from the Install list box. Use the function buttons to move names from one list to the other. For more information, click on  $\blacksquare$  next to the name.

## **Customizing Accessories**

## **Selecting Import/Export Filters**

Filters translate information from one file format to another, making it possible for you to open images created in other applications in Corel GALLERY 2. Choose which import and export filters you want installed by adding or deleting filter names to and from the Install list box. Use the function buttons to move names from one list to the other. For more information, click on  $\blacksquare$  next to the name.

# **Selecting TrueType Fonts**

Choose which fonts you want installed by adding or deleting font names to and from the Install list box. Use the function buttons to move names from one list to the other. For more information, click on In next to the name.

**Note:** The more fonts installed, the slower the performance of Windows will be.

## **Selecting TrueType Font Groups**

Select the font groups that you want installed by checking or clearing the check boxes next to the group names. Each group name (Advertising, Basic, Books, Office, etc.) represents a series of individual fonts of a particular style. To install an entire font group, simply enable the desired font group checkbox.

### **Customizing Font Groups:**

The TrueType Font Selection dialog box allows you to install only the fonts you require from a specific group. Click Customize (the Font Selection dialog box appears) and select the fonts you want to install.

### **Adding Individual Fonts:**

As an alternative to installing fonts by groups, use the Add Individual Font(s) button to install fonts individually. Click the Add Individual Font(s) button (the Font Selection dialog box appears) and select the fonts you want to install. As each font belongs to a group, the font group checkboxes are automatically enabled reflecting the type of font you have selected.

#### Leave Fonts on CD-ROM:

Enable the Leave Fonts on CD-ROM checkbox if you do not want to install fonts permanently on your hard drive. If you do so, you must load the CD-ROM to access fonts in the future. Accessing fonts directly from the CD-ROM saves both disk space and system memory.

# **Selecting a Scanner Driver**

To use a scanner with Corel GALLERY 2, you must first install the appropriate <u>scanner driver</u>. The current settings are displayed on the right-hand side of the dialog box. Pertinent installation information and tips relating to the selected scanner are displayed in the Notes section.

## **Dialog Box Options**

### **Scanner List Box**

Click the down arrow to the right of the Scanners list box and select a scanner name.

## **Settings**

Choose settings for your scanner in the options and value drop-down list boxes.

#### OK

Finalizes the scanner selection and returns to the previous dialog box.

#### Cancel

Clears any selections and returns to the previous dialog box.

## Starting the Installation

This is the last step before the installation process begins. If you choose Install, all the applications, files and options that you selected will be unarchived and loaded onto your hard drive.

Throughout the installation process, Corel GALLERY 2 will display a dialog box showing the percentage of the installation that has been completed, as well as a running list of the files being copied. A new program group and icons representing the Corel GALLERY 2 applications will automatically be created in the Program Manager. If you have any problems or questions about the installation, consult the Corel GALLERY 2 User Manual.

# **Starting the Installation**

**Note:** Users can run Setup from the Setup directory to install the applications to their workstations.

# **Updating the Autoexec.bat File**

For your scanner to work with Corel GALLERY 2, the autoexec.bat file in the root directory of your hard drive must be updated with the new <u>scanner driver</u> information.

## **Dialog Box Options**

## **Update**

Incorporates scanner driver information into the autoexec.bat file. A backup file called autoexec.cor is created before any changes are made.

## **Don't Update**

Leaves the autoexec.bat file as it is but creates a new file (autoexec.cor) that incorporates the scanner driver information.

# **Updating the Config.sys File**

For your scanner to work with Corel GALLERY 2, the config.sys file in the root directory of your hard drive must be updated with the new <u>scanner driver</u> information.

# **Dialog Box Options**

## **Update**

Incorporates scanner driver information into the config.sys file. A backup file called config.cor is created before any changes are made.

## **Don't Update**

Leaves the config.sys file as it is but creates a new file (config.cor) that incorporates the scanner driver information.

## **Selecting Corel GALLERY 2 Options**

Choose which application files you want installed to your hard drive by checking or clearing the check boxes to the left of the file names. Deselecting file options will reduce the amount of disk space required for the application, but will limit the functionality of the software. # **Choosing a Temporary File Location**

Choose one or more of the possible locations for your <u>temporary files</u> by checking or clearing the check boxes to the left of the path names. One check box per local hard drive or partition will be available up to a maximum of three. The free disk space currently available on each hard drive is listed in the right-hand column.

**Note:** If you don't select a temporary file location, the program will assign one for you on the C drive.

# **Temporary Files**

A temporary storage area where data can be placed when your system runs out of memory. If, for instance, you are working on a large graphics file in Corel GALLERY 2 that exceeds the capabilities of your RAM, your system will automatically transfer some of the data to temporary files on your hard drive.

## **Choosing a Program Group**

Choose the program group in which you want the Corel GALLERY 2 icons to be inserted.

The **Program Group** box shows the default group name that will be used. The default group name is GALLERY 2. You can type a different group name, using letter characters only, in the box. (You cannot create a program group using special characters, such as commas, colons, etc.) If the name you type is not an existing group, the setup program creates that group and adds the Corel GALLERY 2 icons (Corel GALLERY 2, Corel CAPTURE, Corel FONT-MASTER) to it.

The **Existing Program Groups** list box includes the names of all groups present in Program Manager. Click the arrow on the right to see the list. Highlight a group name to add the Corel GALLERY 2 icons to it.

# **Selecting Albums**

Corel GALLERY 2 includes four comprehensive albums containing 15,000 clipart images, 500 photos, 500 fonts, and 85 multimedia (sound and video) files.

Install these files to your hard drive to maximize the principle functionality of Corel GALLERY 2 (e.g. searches, batch editing). Such an installation will, however, require more space on your hard drive.

Select the albums that you want installed by checking or clearing the check boxes next to the group names.

**Note:** You can listen to the sound (WAV) files only if you have a sound card installed in your computer.
