

## Additions to the MacSLIP Scripting Language

The `define` command (similar to the `set` command) allows the script to define permanent variables at script execution time.

```
define [/g] [/h] variable-name string
```

The `/g` flag sets the global attribute; the `/h` flag makes the variable's value hidden. NOTE: Don't prefix variable-name with "\$". Example:

```
define user "rick"
```

```
define /h password "abcdefgh"
```
