James F. Strange, author of the captions in this booklet, is professor of religious studies at the University of South Florida. From 1981 to 1989 he served as dean of the College of Arts and Letters at the university.

Strange has directed the University of South Florida Excavations at Sepphoris, in Lower Galilee, since 1983. In 1982 he directed the university's Archaeological Survey in Lower Galilee and was associate director of the Meiron Excavation Project, in Upper Galilee, from 1974 to 1981.
