CC: "your UserName" (return)

After you enter in your Request, use the Ctrl+Z keys to end your message and send it to **IAMU**. If you want to retain a copy of your Request in your Mail Box, insert your UserName into the CC: prompt; otherwise you may leave that field blank if you do not need an extra copy.

If you already have been granted Forum access, you may enter the

Association's "Custom Forum " while on-line to Delphi. From any Main

Menu prompt - type in: GO GROUPS CUSTOM 100 (return)
