- -- Click the back of the computer. You can take a peek, but no movies will play.
- -- Click the Tours button. You'll see the 8 tour folders, but they won't play movies.
- -- Click the Map button. You can navigate through the program and, if there's a movie attached to a part you click, that movie will automatically play for you.
- -- Click the Index button. You'll see the parts that either have movies or Zip Data animations. In the full program, everything is listed here.
