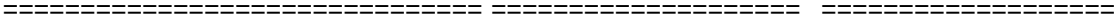

1994 FEDERAL & ONT. INCOME TAX

This 1-2-3 template originated from a 1983 VISICALC template prepared by Prof. John McKirdy and myself. From 1987 and 1988 some ideas were borrowed from Mel Hall via the PC Club of Toronto. The spreadsheet is basically a two column vertical one with Schedules 1 & 7 located at the end, other schedules in a separate spreadsheet. The menu at (HOME) takes you to everything. (Press F5, then the sheet name.) You are expected to enter a number when you see <E> or <S1> etc. (Reverse Video), but black (protected) cells are calculated automatically. The split window at the bottom facilitates what-if studies: When you alter something, the Bottom-Line changes. If you need other schedules, do TSCHE94.WK1 (Rename it) and transfer values to this sheet (TAXONT94).

The elite group who register help me and each other (through me) to ensure an accurate tool by late March."

This template is based on the T1 form itself. I have tried to match the form closely, obeying Revenue Canada's rules, but stay on one screen. I have included line numbers, etc., where feasible. Printing the form directly for electronic filing is so far not practical; it must be copied to the T1 form. Please check the README.1ST file on the disk (Type README at the prompt.)

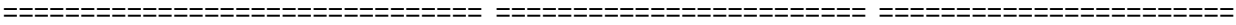
