1) Changes in this release

The date format can be customized and a WAV file can be selected for the alarm. Patch **a** corrects a calendar problem at VGA resolution.

2) List of files

3) Installation

- a) Copy all files listed in Section 2 except `BWCC.DLL` to a subdirectory. Do not mark the files or directory read-only. If you are upgrading from a previous version of KazClock, do not delete file `KAZCLOCK.INI` since it contains your registration information.
- b) Copy file `BWCC.DLL` to your `WINDOWS\SYSTEM` directory if a copy is not already there.
- c) Run program `KAZCLOCK.EXE` using either the File Manager or Program Manager. You will be prompted for your name and company so that your copy of the program can be personalized.

4) Network Drives

If the software is installed on a network drive, file `KAZCLOCK.EXE` must have the shareable attribute set or the installation and registration will fail.

5) License Agreement
