This file contains important information you will need to know upon installing and using Jump Color v2.0. If you enlarge the Write window to its maximum size, this document will be easier to read. To do so, click the Maximize button in the top-right corner of the window or open the Control menu in the top-left corner of the Write window (press **Alt + Spacebar**), and then choose the **Maximize** command.

To move through the document, press your **Page Up** or **Page Down** keys or click the arrows at the top and bottom of the scroll bar along the right side of the Write window.

To print the document, choose the **Print** command from the **File** menu.

Installation

By the time you read this file, you should have the program files in a special directory. If this isn't the case, then:

1. Create a new directory (e.g. c:\jumpcolr).
2. Copy these three files contained in the unzipped **jmpclr.zip** to the new directory:
jumpcolr.exe
jumpcolr.hlp
jumpcolr.wri
3. Move the file **threed.vbx** to your Windows\System directory.
4. Make sure you have the file **vbrun300.dll** in your Windows\System directory (Jump Color won't run without it!). If you don't have it, you can obtain it from CompuServe (GO WINSHARE, LIB 1).
5. Create a Program Item in the Program Group of your choice using Program Manager. (Read your Windows manual for detailed instructions on this).
6. Enjoy!

Jump Color ("the Software") is a Windows Help/Multimedia Viewer utility licensed by Screaming Tiki (tm). The Software includes the following files:

JUMPCOLR.EXE - The main executable file.
JUMPCOLR.HLP - A Windows help file.
JUMPCOLR.WRI - This file.

Shareware license

You are free to distribute the entire unmodified contents of the distribution package to anyone you wish. You may NOT distribute any other programs that utilizes the Software without obtaining a Registered User License for the Software from Screaming Tiki. For a period of no more than 21 days, you may use, test and duplicate the enclosed version of the Software. Thereafter if you wish to continue using the Software you must register the Software with Screaming Tiki, or else you must cease all use of the Software. You will be an infringer if you do not pay the registration fee and continue to use this version of the Software for more than 21 days.

Registered User License

If you pay the registration fee for the Software to Screaming Tiki, Screaming Tiki will grant a non-exclusive license for one natural person to use one copy of the software regardless if the owner of the license is a person or a business ("the Licensee"). No purported transfer of the license shall be effective until the licensee notifies Screaming Tiki of the name and address of the person receiving the license ("the Transferee"), and transfers all copies of the Software to the Transferee, and removes or destroys any other copies of the Software in the possession of, or under the control of the Licensee.
